

## TRAINING COMMAND–ARMY SCHOOL AND UNIT FLAGS

1. The Training Command–Army schools and units are entitled to fly unit flags. Details of the approved designs for these flags are as follows:

- a. **Regional Training Centres.** Regional Training Centres flags are to be 1.8 m x 90 cm in size, consisting of three horizontal stripes of Green (1/4), Yellow (1/2) and Green (1/4). A black Rising Sun badge, 41.5 cm in height, is displayed centrally on the flag. The words TRAINING GROUP, in upper case, 56 mm in height and in black, are displayed to the left and right of the badge respectively. The unit number, in yellow and 14 cm in height, is to be positioned centrally below the badge in the lower green stripe.
- b. **Corps schools.** Corps school flags are to be 1.8 m x 90 cm in size, consisting of three equal horizontal stripes of Green (1/3), Yellow (1/3) and Green (1/3). The corps badge, with the exception of the School of Armour, is displayed centrally on the flag; the School of Armour flag is to display a Mailed Fist emblem in lieu of the Corps badge. All badges and emblems are to be black and 60 cm in height.
- c. **Army schools.** Army school flags are to be 1.8 m x 90 cm in size, consisting of three equal horizontal stripes of Green (1/3), Yellow (1/3) and Green (1/3). The unit emblem, 60 cm in height, is displayed centrally on the flag.
- d. **Joint schools.** Joint schools are to fly the Australian Defence Force Ensign (ADFE), in accordance with Defence Instruction (General) ADMIN 12–1—*Australian Defence Force Ensign, Personal Flags of Senior Officers, Car Flags and Star Plates* (filed as Army ADMIN 30–1).
- e. **Officer training establishments.** The flags for individual officer training establishments are as follows:

1	Royal Military College	A 1.8 m x 90 cm flag consisting of three horizontal stripes, Dark Blue (1/3), Scarlet (1/3), and Dark Blue (1/3), with a 40 mm black stripe superimposed across the Scarlet, and the Unit emblem, 60cm in height, displayed centrally
2	Queensland University Regiment	A 1.8 m x 90 cm flag of Slate Grey, with the Unit emblem, 77 cm in height, displayed centrally
3	Sydney University Regiment	A 1.8 m x 90 cm flag of two equal vertical stripes, Yellow (leading edge) and Royal Blue, with the Regimental badge (45 cm in height), in Black and Red, displayed centrally
4	University of New South Wales	A 1.8 m x 90 cm flag of two 45 cm horizontal stripes, Gold over Black, with the Regimental badge (in colour and 60 cm in height) displayed centrally
5	Melbourne University Regiment	A 1.8 m x 90 cm flag of three horizontal stripes, Black (36.5 cm), Azure Blue (17 cm) and Black (36.5 cm), with the Regimental badge (60 cm in height) displayed centrally
6	Monash University Regiment	A 1.8m x 90cm flag of Royal Blue with the Regimental badge (outlined in Red and 60cm in height) displayed centrally

7	Adelaide University Regiment	A 1.8 m x 90 cm flag of Khaki with the Regimental badge (in colour and 60 cm in height) displayed centrally and the letters AUR in the canton
8	Western Australia University Regiment	A 1.8 m x 90 cm flag of scarlet with the Regimental badge (in colour and 60 cm in height) displayed centrally
