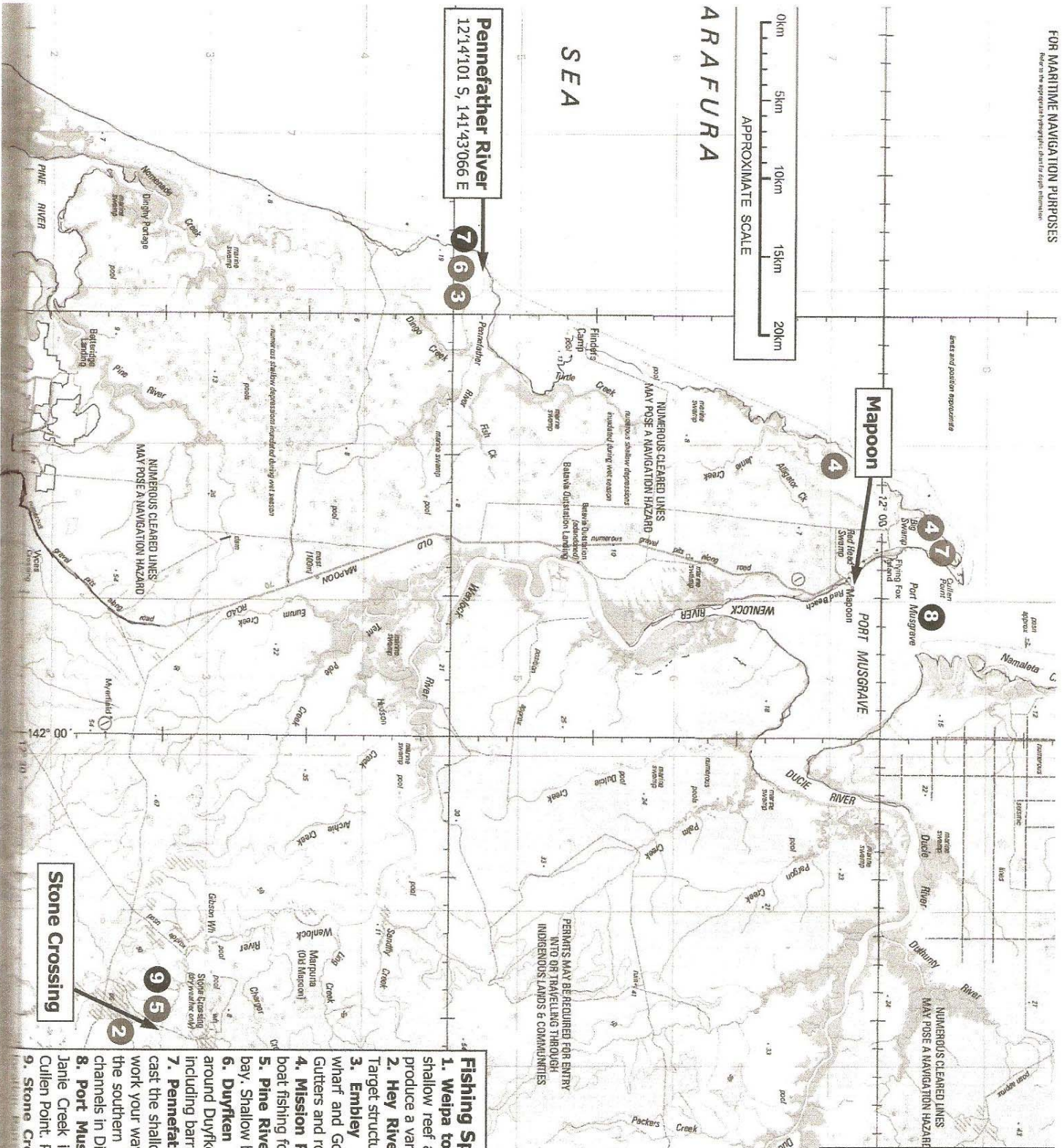

### Camp Areas

- Weipa Campground** - Beachfront Lodge & Villa's, cabins, camping, boat hire and mine tours. [www.campweipa.com](http://www.campweipa.com) 07 4069 7871. Book your camping permits from Weipa Campground for Stone Crossing, Pennefather River and Mapoon.
- Stone Crossing** - beautiful freshwater camping spot on the Wenlock River. Various spots to camp.
- Pennefather River** - Very Scenic camping area at the mouth of the river with some great fishing.
- Mapoon** - Camping areas at Cullen Point and Janie Creek. Toilet and shower block at Mapoon.

### Boat Ramps

- Evans Landing** - Kerr Point Rd. 2 lane concrete ramp with pontoon, lighting, bins, tap water and toilets. 12°39'88.4 S, 141°50'81.0 E
- Rocky Point** - Marina Rd. Single lane exposed and tide restricted concrete ramp. 12°37'19.5 S, 141°52'6.4 E
- Mission River Bank Launch** - Under the southern end of Mission River Bridge. 12°36'11.2 S, 141°53'6.5 E
- Andoom Bank Launch** - Mapoon side of Andoom Creek 11km north of Weipa. 12°33'60.3 S, 141°52'4.5 E
- Stone Crossing Bank Launch**
- Pennefather River Bank Launch**
- Mapoon** - Cullen Point and Janie Creek

### Fishing Spots and Tips

- Weipa to Thud Point** - You will find plenty of rocky areas and shallow reef along the beach between Weipa and thud Point that produce a variety of pelagic and reef fish.
- Hey River** - Salmon, barra, grunter, trevally and fingermark. Target structure such as rocks, gutters and creek junctions.
- Embley River** - Land based fishing around Evans Landing wharf and Gombung Point for grunter, jewfish and other species. Gutters and rock bars in the river can fish well.
- Mission River** - Around the bridge offers great land based and boat fishing for various species or work junctions up the river.
- Pine River Bay** - Work the small creeks or the channel into the bay. Shallow bay and creek mouths so work the tides.
- Duyfken Point** - The shoals, shallow reefs and rocky outcrops around Duyfken and Jantz Points produce a wide variety of species including barra, trout, mackerel, cobia, jewfish and fingermark.
- Pennefather River** - A great fishing and camping area. Sight cast the shallow water near the southern end of the river mouth or work your way up the river along the rock ledge and deep water on the southern bank for a wide variety of species. Work the narrow channels in Dingo, Turtle and Fish Creeks. Travel on high water.
- Port Musgrave** - Shallow bay is choppy in windy conditions. Janie Creek is a good option when it is windy. Deep water off Cullen Point. Plenty of options within the bay in calm weather.
- Stone Crossing** - A beautiful freshwater fishing and camping
