

1. I understand that CRC Care has developed a technology called mat care that can effectively lock PFCs in water and soil.

2. They have said defence was aware of this technology but have not approached them to discuss rolling this out in affected communities like Oakey.

3. Was defence aware of this Australian produced technology?

Defence has trialled this with small amounts of waste water at some RAAF bases.

4. Is defence considering the use of this to remedy affected towns across the country?

Defence is currently conducting trials of a number of remediation technologies at RAAF Base Williamtown and Army Aviation Centre Oakey to identify options for large scale groundwater remediation. Defence is in contact with CRC CARE.
