INAPPROPRIATE USE OF ICT

What: ADFIS confirmed that ^{47F} [REDACTED] F (ARES) is under investigation by NSWPOL for transmission of pornographic material. ^{47F} [REDACTED] F sent pornographic material over the DRN in early 2011 whilst working as a civilian contractor for Thales. ^{47F} [REDACTED] F is alleged to have video taped one of the files he sent be email without the knowledge of a civilian female. When the civilian female became aware of the video she made a complaint to VICPOL. VICPOL handed the matter to the AFP who during the week 22-27 Jul 12 handed the matter to NSWPOL. No charges have been laid.

What: Thales removed the individual from duty under their code of conduct for the transmission of pornographic material. ADFIS is supporting the NSWPOL investigation. ADFIS is liaising with DSA for related ICT matters. Members posted unit is aware.
