Material taken into account

 - d. the *Guidelines published by the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner under section 93A of the FOI Act* (the Guidelines);

- e. the Principles on open public sector information issued by the Information Commissioner; and
- f. advice from Headquarters Joint Operations Command whose duties relate to the management of the matters referred to in the document.

Decision
