EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Determination 2001/11

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2000/1, Conditions of Service (“the Principal Determination”), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*, which includes provisions dealing with the payment of travelling and meal allowances for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) in Australia.

The adjustments made by this Determination are in accordance with the *ADF Enterprise Productivity Arrangement 1999 – 2002*, which requires the rates of travelling and meal allowances to be reviewed in the June and December quarters of each year, in line with recommendations made by the Department of Employment, Workplace Relations and Small Business (DEWRSB) for the Australian Public Service. The meal allowance adjustments reflect movements in the Consumer Price Index in the 12 months to December 2000, less an adjustment that was made on 1 July 2000 to anticipate cost increases related to the introduction of the goods and services tax. Accommodation rates are set following a survey conducted by DEWRSB.

Clause 7.3.9 of the Principal Determination sets out the rates of meal allowance payable to ADF personnel in certain circumstances where service provided meals are unavailable. The amendments to clause 7.3.9 increase the meal allowance rates by between 3% and 3.5%.

Part 2 of Schedule 2 sets out the rates of full day travelling allowance for ADF personnel. The amendments to Part 2:

- increase the accommodation amounts for Adelaide, Canberra, Darwin, Hobart and Melbourne by between 2.4% and 4.5%;
- increase the tier 2 (ie medium cost) country centres accommodation amounts by approximately 2.8%;
- increase the meal rates component of travelling allowance by between 3.4% and 3.7%; and
- increase the incidental rates component of travelling allowance by 2.8%.

Part 3 of Schedule 2 sets out the accommodation expenses for high cost country centres. The amendments to Part 3 vary the accommodation amounts by between +29.4% and -11.1%.

Part 4 of Schedule 2 lists the centres classified as tier 2 country centres. The amendments to Part 4 include 10 new localities. A number of localities (such as Ballarat and Cairns) that were formerly high cost country centres have been added to this Part.

Part 5 of Schedule 2 sets out the meal and incidental rates component of travelling allowance after 21 days. The amendments to Part 5 increase the meal amount by 4.6% and increase the incidental amount by 0.9%.
