Note Clause 6.1.5 sets out the conditions under which these rates apply to members living at relevant localities. In particular, subclause 6.1.5 (3) describes certain situations when a member with dependants is entitled to the rates mentioned in column 3 rather than column 2.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Determination 2001/17

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2000/1, Conditions of Service (“the Principal Determination”), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*, which includes provisions dealing with district and various locality specific allowances.

The adjustments made by this Determination are in accordance with the *ADF Enterprise Productivity Arrangement 1999 – 2002*, which requires the rates of isolated and remote localities allowances to be reviewed in the June quarter each year, in line with recommendations made by the Department of Employment Workplace Relations and Small Business (DEWRSB) for the Australian Public Service. The rates of the allowances, and many of the localities involved, are the same as those provided from time to time for Australian Public Service employees of the Department of Defence.

The DEWRSB recommendations take account of movement in the All Groups component of the Consumer Price Index, average weekly earnings and an annual cost-of-living survey.

Clauses 3, 4 and 5 of this Determination increase the Woomera allowance rates by 5.1%.

Clauses 6 and 7 of this Determination increase the amounts of Port Wakefield allowance by 5.2%.

Clauses 8 and 9 of this Determination increase the amounts of bare base allowance by 5.4%.

Clauses 10 and 11 of this Determination increase the amounts of Antarctic allowance by 5.3%.

Clause 12 of this Determination provides for a new schedule of district allowance rates. The amendments to Part 2 increase the amounts by between 5.2% and 6%.

The variation in the increases is due to the effect of rounding on the underlying data.

This Determination commences on the day on which it is made, as provided by subsection 58B(4) of the *Defence Act 1903*.
