# EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

## Defence Determination 2001/31

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2000/1, Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*. Schedule 2 to the Principal Determination sets out the amount of travelling allowance for accommodation and meals for members of various ranks who travel in connection with their duties.

The adjustments made by this Determination are in accordance with the *ADF Enterprise Productivity Arrangement 1999 – 2002*, which requires the rates of travelling and meal allowances to be reviewed in the June and December quarters of each year, in line with recommendations made by the Department of Employment, Workplace Relations and Small Business (DEWRSB) for the Australian Public Service. Accommodation rates are set following a survey conducted by DEWRSB.

This Determination replaces Parts 2, 3 and 4 of Schedule 2 to the Principal Determination, which deal with full-day travelling allowance. The amounts listed in Schedule 2 for meals remain unchanged but the amendment makes changes to the rates for accommodation in the range of 11.1% to –9.3%. These changes reflect seasonal variation in the cost of accommodation in centres such as Darwin.

This Determination commences on 19 November 2001, as provided by subsection 58B (4) of the *Defence Act 1903*.
