EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Determination 2001/32

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2000/1, Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*, which includes provisions dealing with the payment of vehicle allowance, and other allowances associated with relocation, for members of the Australian Defence Force in Australia.

The adjustments made by this Determination are in accordance with the *ADF Enterprise Productivity Arrangement 1999 – 2002*, which requires the rates of allowance to be reviewed in the December quarter each year. The allowances are increased in line with recommendations made by the Department of Employment, Workplace Relations and Small Business for the Australian Public Service.

The following rates have been increased by 2.5% in line with the All Groups Consumer Price Index increase over the period September 2000 to September 2001:

- Clause 5, an allowance to cover an additional payment if a member's child is required to change school as a result of relocation (amends subclause 4.2.5 (1) of the Principal Determination);
- Clause 6, telephone reconnection costs (amends subclause 4.2.6 (1) of the Principal Determination);
- Clause 7, motor vehicle transfer costs (amends clause 4.2.7 of the Principle Determination);
- Clause 8, reimbursement of expenses for pet relocation (amends subclause 4.4.1 (2) of the Principal Determination); and
- Clause 10, disturbance allowance (substitutes a new Schedule 4 to the Principal Determination).

The following allowances have been increased by 2.5%, equivalent to the increase in the private motoring component of the Consumer Price Index over the period September 2000 to September 2001:

- Clause 4 provides for an increase in an additional vehicle allowance, to reimburse the member for the additional costs associated with using the member's private vehicle to carry passengers or heavy equipment, or to tow a trailer (amends clause 3.2.10 of the Principal Determination); and
- Clause 9 provides for increased rates of vehicle allowance (listed in Schedule 3 to the Principal Determination).

This Determination commences on the day on which it is made, as provided by subsection 58B(4) of the *Defence Act 1903*.
