EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Determination 2001/7

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2000/1, Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*, which includes provisions authorising additional recreation leave and the payment of deployment allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) assigned for duty with a United Nations (UN) mission or similar force.

The purpose of this Determination is to authorise conditions of service for certain members of the ADF who have been deployed for service with the UN Mission in Ethiopia and Eritrea and the International Military Advisory and Training Team in Sierra Leone.

Part 2 of Schedule 10 of the Principal Determination sets out the additional days of recreation leave which accrue to members who perform duty in a leave year at certain localities overseas in connection with a deployment with a UN mission or similar force. Members who perform duty in a leave year at those localities in connection with such a deployment receive up to 10 additional days of recreation leave for that leave year. (The actual additional days of recreation leave a member is entitled to is worked out under a formula which is set out in clause 8.1.11 of the Principal Determination.) Clauses 4 and 5 of this Determination amend Part 2 of the Schedule by inserting Ethiopia, Eritrea and Sierra Leone.

Schedule 13 of the Principal Determination sets out the operational areas that attract deployment allowance. Clause 6 of this Determination amends that Schedule by inserting Ethiopia, Eritrea and Sierra Leone.

This Determination is taken to have commenced on 15 January 2001, the date on which the operational areas took effect. The Determination was made as soon as practicable after that date.

The retrospective application of this Determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such person.
