# EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

## Defence Determination 2001/9

Defence Determination 2000/1, Conditions of Service (“the Principal Determination”), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*, includes provisions enabling certain members, who are separated from their dependants, to undertake or receive reunion travel after periods of continuous full-time service or other continuous service.

The categories of members that are eligible for reunion travel are set out in subclause 3.5.3 (1) of the Principal Determination. This Determination amends the subclause to apply to a member whose only dependant is a spouse who is a member posted to a different locality. (Ordinarily, the other categories of members specified in the subclause would cover these members. However, the explicit coverage of this group of members ensures that no unintended gaps arise.)

This Determination commences on the day on which it is made, as provided by subsection 58B(4) of the *Defence Act 1903*.
