SENSITIVITY: While it is not clear as to whether any images were captured by the cadet, this incident has heightened sensitivity given the Skype incident in March this year.

KEY ISSUES:

- At 1815h Thursday, 25 Aug 11, a female midshipman at ADFA reported the discovery of a camera enabled mobile phone within a shower cubicle.
- The camera is the property of a [REDACTED] Air Force Officer Cadet.
- ADFA have notified the Australian Defence Force Investigative Service (ADFIS) who commenced investigations at 1903h.
- After taking initial statements from the complainant, ADFIS notified ACT Policing at 2255h. It is likely that the female midshipman will make a complaint to ACT Policing.
- The female midshipman is safe and has been provided with access to appropriate support. She will spend tonight at the house of the family of a fellow cadet.
