WELCOME TO RANSAC 28/2009

1. Congratulations on your selection to attend the RAN Staff Acquaint Course (RANSAC) 28/09. The Course has been constructed to help you in your future career and I am sure you will find the experience enjoyable and professionally rewarding.
2. RANSAC is conducted in three phases covering a twelve and a half-month period. Phase One concentrates on basic staff skills and knowledge of Navy management. This focus will be broadened in Phase Two to Defence planning and management and maritime warfare history and strategy. During Phase Three, you will study maritime strategy, Australian Defence and Joint Operations planning.
3. Phase One and Three of the RANSAC are residential as programmed activities or a requirement for private study occur every day during the course, including weekends and evenings.
