

TRUMPET AND BUGLE CALLS, AND REGIMENTAL MARCHES OF THE AUSTRALIAN ARMY

Instructions for bugle and trumpet calls for the Australian Army

- The bugle and trumpet calls to be used by the Australian Army are issued as a Defence School of Music instruction to bands and pipes and drums.

Cavalry and artillery trumpet calls

- Cavalry and artillery trumpet calls are to be played on an 'E' flat cavalry trumpet.

Infantry bugle calls

- Infantry bugle calls and Armoured/Artillery Mounted calls are to be played on a 'B' flat bugle. B flat cornets or trumpets are not to be used for this purpose.
