

CHAPTER 21

RAAMC ASSOCIATIONS

General

2101. A number of RAAMC Associations based on former RAAMC units, exist in various parts of Australia. While these associations have no officially recognised link with the RAAMC, their success and continued existence is one of the important elements of fostering esprit de corps within the RAAMC.

2102. For this reason, every effort is to be made to advertise the existence of these associations and wherever possible, their activities and projects are to be supported by current members of the Corps. Serving members of the Corps should be encouraged to interact with and join RAAMC Associations.

Financial commitment

2103. The Corps Committee is the only avenue by which any financial commitment may be made to any RAAMC Association.

2104. Any request for assistance or donation is to be made in writing, to a Corps Committee Meeting. The request is to detail the purpose of the assistance or donation and what benefit the Corps will derive from such a commitment.

2105. No individual Corps member is to make any financial commitment on behalf of the Corps, to any RAAMC Association, without the prior approval of the Corps Committee.
