

## **LOST & FOUND ON THE WESTERN FRONT**

Of the eight Australian soldiers believed to have been buried near the hamlet of Westhoek in Belgium but who were not later exhumed for reinterment, seven have been identified.

They are:

- 2Lt LJ Corrigan, 22nd Australian Infantry Battalion;
- Pte JA Gibbens, 29th Australian Infantry Battalion;
- Pte J Hunter, 49th Australian Infantry Battalion;
- Sgt CN McArthur, 48th Australian Infantry Battalion;
- Sgt G Calder, 51st Australian Infantry Battalion;
- Pte GR Storey, 51st Australian Infantry Battalion; and
- Pte W Williams, 51st Australian Infantry Battalion.
