

ADFA SINGLE SERVICE TRAINING TWO BRAVO (SST2B)
AIM AND COMPETENCIES

Aim

1. The purpose of SST2B is to:
 - a. continue to shape cadets towards understanding the responsibilities and obligations of the military profession;
 - b. further inculcation of cadets in the skills, knowledge and attitude required of an Army officer; and
 - c. further develop the cadet's individual marksmanship skills on the F88 Steyr and F89 Light Support Weapon.

Scope of training

2. The practical training focus of SST2B is to progress OCDTs along the Training the Battle Shot continuum. This Battle Block will transition OCDTs from the Elementary Application of Fire and introduce them to the Advanced Application of Fire. Training will culminate with OCDTs undertaking Live Fire 6 for the F88 and F89.

Standards

3. SST2B is a competency based course and requires OCDTs to meet set standards for each competency. OCDTs will be assessed and evaluated throughout the course and maximum effort will be expected from all OCDTs. Inherent with competency is attitude and character. Trainees will be expected to display the attributes expected of an Officer and to live by the Military Ethic.
