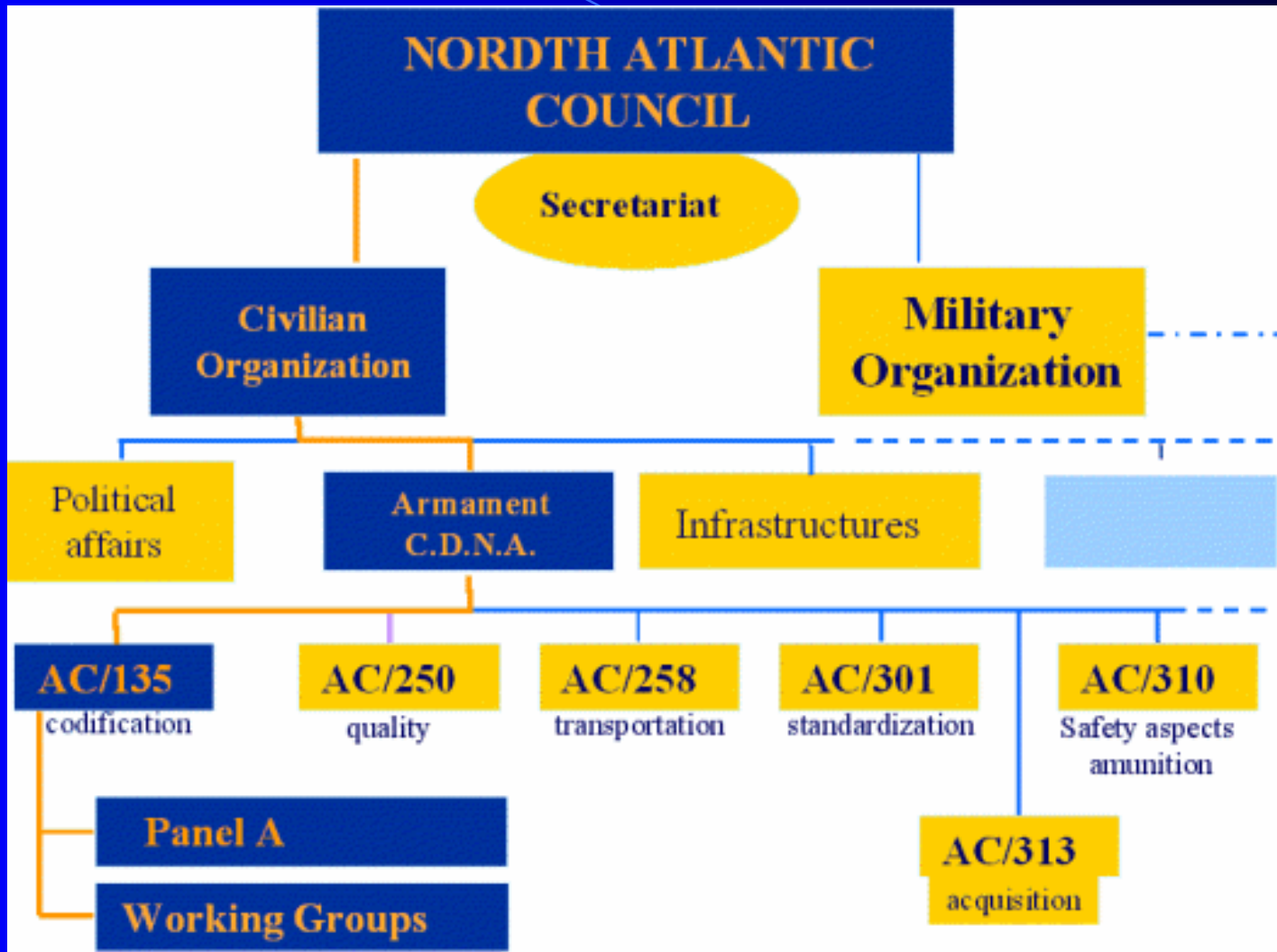

Principle of NCSCRs adoption

- Issue proposed and debated at Panel A
 - Exchanges of documents (between two meetings) through NABS
 - Formal debates and open discussions during the meeting
- Review of the issue as far as it is not “ready”
 - Actions are raised to improve the initial proposal
 - collaboration between leader nations on some issues
- Proposal raised under silence procedure
- ACodP-1 updating (January and July)
- Principle of consensus
 - Each NATO member has a “veto” right

Example of Panel A issue



- **Origin** : GBR has a need to manage efficiently the aircraft spare parts through the NCS
- **Historic of the process**
 - ✓ Initial proposal ; comments from nations
 - ✓ Preparation of a NCSCR
 - ✓ Debates ; review ; final proposal
 - ✓ Adoption of the « new rule » and implementation in the systems

Spare parts subjected to Traceability



- Origin GBR early 2006
(prior 108th Panel A meeting)
- Nations vues : Divergences
 - ✓ Aspects dealt outside codification area
 - ✓ Tries to use NCS to manage those spare parts
 - ✓ So far , current rules non satisfying



Spare parts subjected to Traceability



- **At 109° Panel A meeting**
- **Proposals**
 - create a new RNVC code
 - Forbid the automatic LAR transactions
 - Add a data in LSAs
 - Mention specific need in the L07
- **After 109° Panel A meeting**
- GBR + FRA proposed an compromise
- DEU is opposed and stop the process
The silence procedure is broken



Spare parts subjected to Traceability



- **Prior 110° Panel A meeting**
- New Perspectives : FRA reopen this issue taking into account the historic.
- Nations vues :
 - ✓ Current Rules non satisfying
 - ✓ FRA wishes to forbid automatic LAR on narrow concept NSNs.
 - ✓ During Summer DEU reviewed its position move in the same way than France

Spare parts subjected to Traceability

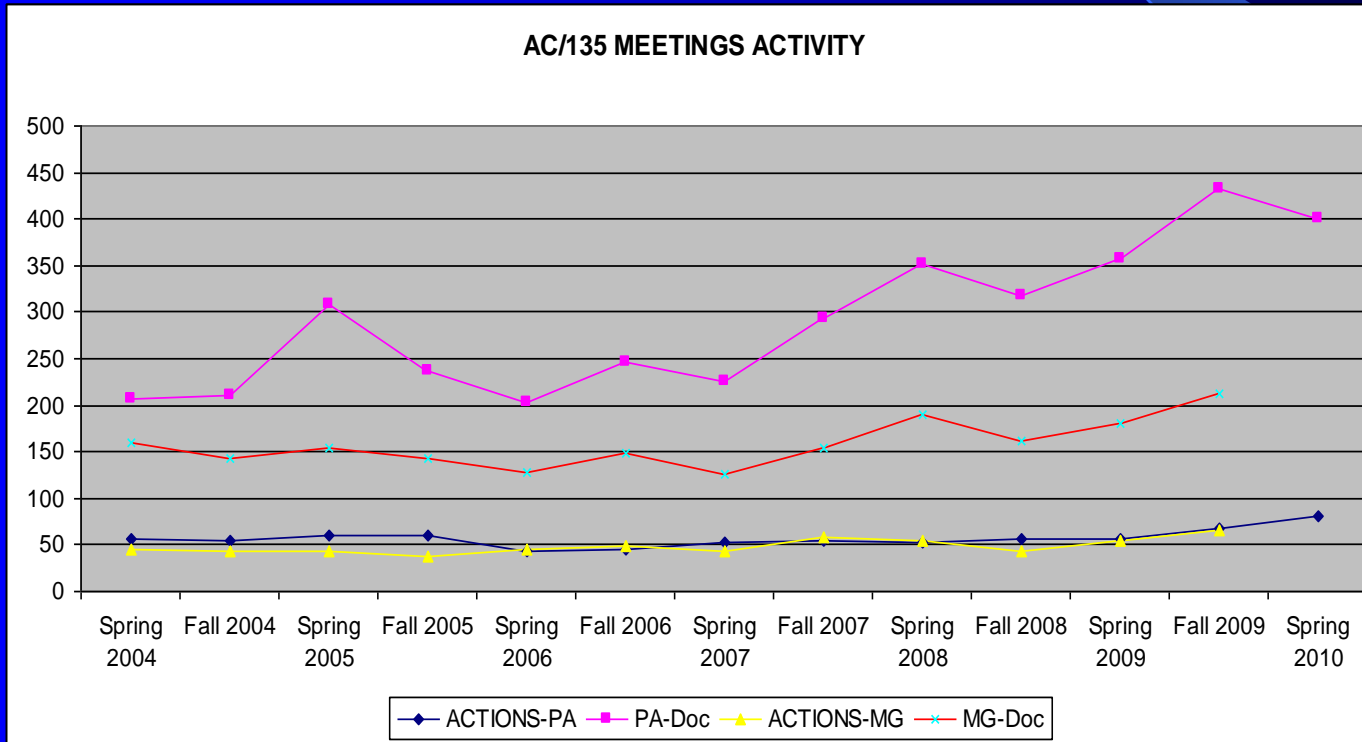


- **Situation at the end of the 110° Panel A meeting**
 - No opposition to forbid the automatic LAR
 - NCSCR in preparation
 - Changes proposed under silence procedure
 - ACodP-1 Jan08 will be updated if nations O.K.
- **Situation after the 110° Panel A meeting**
- End December 2007 (end of silence procedure).
The silence procedure was not broken
- ACodP-1 Jan08 updated
- Changes in the systems to be taken into account by the nations.
