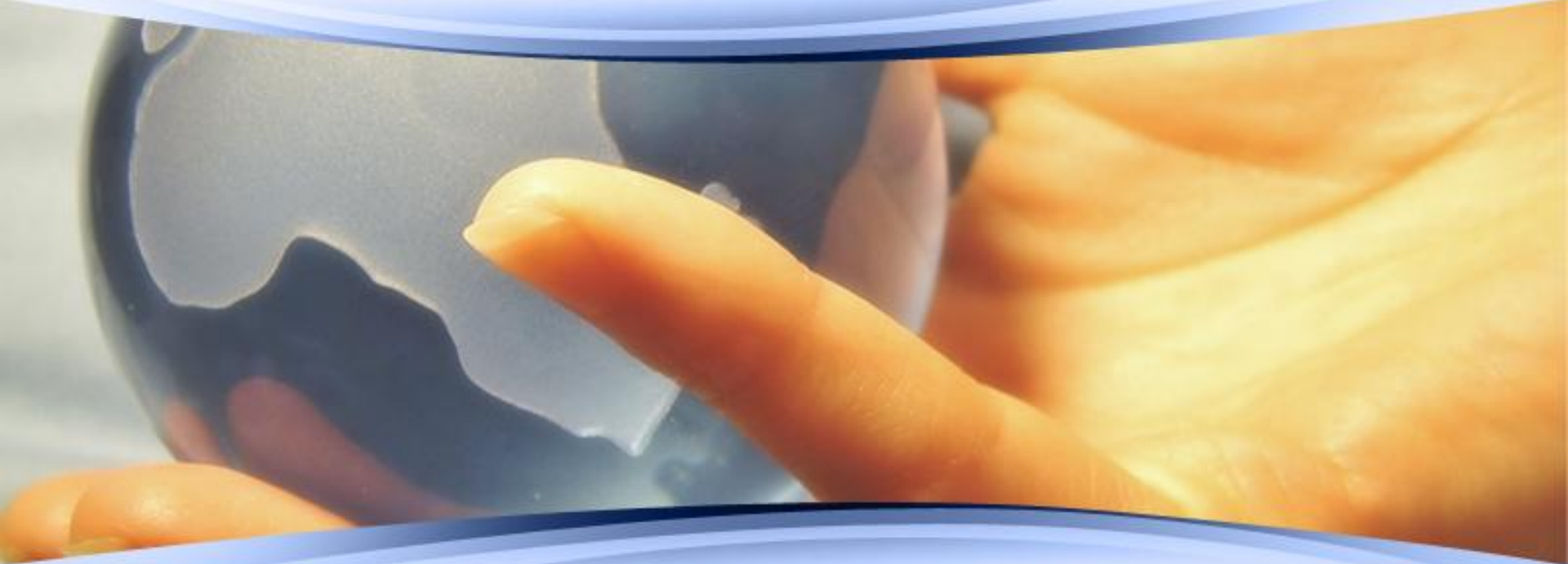

Item Identification Guides (IGs) become Data Requirements (DRs)



- All data capture (input) and all reports (output) can be described using eOTD-i-xml (ISO 22745-30) data requirements.
 - eOTD-q-xml (ISO 22745-35) can be used as a “form-fill” specifications for web and email applications, this is an integral part of Cataloging at Source (C@S).
 - eOTD-r-xml (ISO 22745-40) can be used to exchange quality data encoded to an Open Technical Dictionary (*including NATO mailbox exchanges*)
- ❖ The item name (class) is being changed from mandatory to optional in eOTD-i-xml.
- ❖ The eOTD is being extended to cover concepts used in finance, insurance, real estate, health care, human resources and general business transactions.

ECCMA provides **Registries** used to manage Data Quality



- eOTD* a public registry of Concepts
- eDRR* a public registry of Data Requirements
- eGOR* a public registry of Organizations
- eCLR a registry of Classifications

Researching or resolving ECCMA 0161-1 identifiers using web services is **free** as required under ISO 8000.

Membership in ECCMA is required to request the assignment of 0161-1 identifiers.

* The eOTD, eDRR and eGOR are public registry that enable Cataloging at Source (C@S)

New Membership Structures



- **Associate Member** **\$350 per year**
 - Small Medium Business (ECCMA registries for internal use only)
- **Full Member** **\$5,000 per year**
 - Large Business or Government Agency*
 - Application and service providers (ECCMA registries used to generate sales revenue)
- **Charter Member** **\$50,000 per year**
 - Integrated application providers and special projects

* Special NATO membership: NAMSA and DLIS at Full Member rate (\$5,000 per year), other members of NATO at Associate Member rate (\$350 per year).
