



MAJOR GENERAL GRANT CAVENAGH, AM

Major General Grant Cavenagh is the Head of Land Systems Division (LSD), Defence Material Organisation, located in Victoria Barracks - Melbourne. He is responsible for the acquisition and sustainment of the majority of the Australian Defence Force's land – based systems and equipment.

Major General Cavenagh has extensive experience in major acquisition projects, logistic operations support and business reform. He has commanded logistics organisations at all levels within the Australian Defence Force. Prior to his posting to LSD, Major General Grant Cavenagh was the Commander, Joint Logistics. In this role he was

the strategic logistics advisor to the Chief of the Defence Force and Secretary of Defence, and he commanded the Joint Logistics Command. He has also held appointments including instructional, computer systems development, research, and force preparedness and mobilisation.

Major General Cavenagh is a graduate of the Royal Military College, Army Command and Staff College and Joint Services Staff College. He is a graduate of the Harvard Business School, Advanced Management Program and has a Master of Defence Studies, a Bachelor of Arts and Graduate Diplomas in Computing, Strategic Studies and Management. He is a member of several professional associations, in the fields of

business management, project management and logistics.

Major General Cavenagh received the Order of Australia for his services to logistics and was awarded a Commendation for Distinguished Service as the Commander, Force Logistic Support Group, International Force East Timor.
