## **PHILL BROWN**

Phill Brown is currently the Program Manager, Amphibious Deployment and Sustainment. He has worked in the shipbuilding industry, in both the private and public sector, for over 30 years.

Phill's career started back in 1969 as an apprentice shipwright at the State Dockyard Newcastle NSW. He joined the Australian Government Public Service in 1977, working in Naval Ship Design and Production Directorates.

Phill left the Public Service in 1996 to join Transfield as the Design Manager in Melbourne. In 1997 Phill joined Australian Technology Information, becoming involved in software and radar development and verification. In 1998 he joined Tenix Shipbuilding Western Australia as the Engineering Manager, being promoted to General Manager in 2000. .

In 2002 Phill was appointed General Manager of the Anzac Ship Alliance, and successfully led this unique tripartite arrangement between Defence Materiel Organisation, Saab Systems and Tenix Defence for several years.
