



## **REAR ADMIRAL MARK CAMPBELL, CSC RAN**

Rear Admiral Campbell is a Helicopter Warfare Instructor with substantial aviation, seagoing, support and acquisition experience.

He has about 3,500 flying hours mainly as an anti-submarine tactical co-ordinator in Sea King and Seahawk helicopters. He has also flown S2-G Tracker, UH-1B Iroquois, Wessex 31B, Bell 206B-1, and AS350B Squirrel aircraft and served in HMA Ships *Tobruk*, *Sydney*, *Darwin*, and *Adelaide* as well as HM Ships *Illustrious* and *Invincible* whilst on exchange with the Royal Navy.

Operational deployments have included for Operation Bursa, Operation Damask including Operation Desert Shield and Desert Storm in 1991 and in the North Red Sea enforcing United Nations sanctions against Iraq in 1992.

He took up his appointment as Head Helicopter Systems Division in the Defence Materiel Organisation in Canberra on 1 July 2010.

Admiral Campbell and his wife Sally have three adult sons. He enjoys mountain biking, bush walking, almost any sport and reading military history.
