Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903

Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 0213, RAAF Deseal—Reseal Allowance.¹

Definitions

2. In this Determination—

“adverse working conditions” means those working conditions which are not normally encountered by a member in his employment and which are unusually wet, dirty, cold or otherwise offensive and which require a member to adopt a stooped or cramped posture or to work in a place with poor ventilation;

“member” means a serving member.

RAAF Deseal—Reseal Allowance

3. An allowance called “RAAF Deseal—Reseal Allowance” is payable to a member who, during a day, performs—

- (a) deseal or reseal duties, other than supervision duties, in the fuel tanks on F111 aircraft, under adverse working conditions; or
- (b) supervision, under adverse working conditions, of a member referred to in paragraph (a).

Rate of Allowance

4. Subject to clause 5, RAAF Deseal—Reseal Allowance is payable—
- (a) in respect of a member to whom paragraph 3 (a) applies—at the rate of \$6.00 for each day on which he performs duties under adverse working conditions; and
 - (b) in respect of a member to whom paragraph 3 (b) applies—at the rate of \$3.00 for each day on which he performs supervisory duties under adverse working conditions.

Limit of Allowance

5. Where but for this clause there would be payable to a member, on a day, more than one rate of RAAF Deseal—Reseal Allowance, that member is entitled in respect of that day to payment only of the higher of those rates.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 57 OF 1981

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 provides that the Minister may make determinations on conditions of service which are beneficial to members of the Defence Force.

This Determination provides for the payment of a "RAAF Deseal - Reseal Allowance" to members engaged in deseal and reseal duties in the fuel tanks of F111 aircraft.

The Determination replaces the existing legal cover for the allowance contained in Determination O206, Confined Spaces Allowance.

Date of effect is the date of signature of the Determination.
