Determination under the Defence Act 1903

Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 0606, Outfit Allowance For Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General.¹

Definitions

2. In this Determination—

“member” means a member rendering continuous full time service;

“officer” means a member who is an officer.

Outfit Allowance For Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General

3. An allowance called “Outfit Allowance For Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General” is payable to an officer appointed as aide-de-camp to the Governor-General.

4. An entitlement under this Determination shall be in addition to, and not in substitution for, any entitlement arising under the provisions of regulation 238 of the Military Financial Regulations or regulation 575A or 648 of the Air Force Regulations.

Amount of Allowance

5. Subject to clause 6, the amount of allowance payable to an officer is whichever is the lesser of—

- (a) the cost to the officer of purchasing an article or articles of clothing or luggage specified in Column 1 of the following table; or
- (b) the amount specified in Column 2 of the following table opposite that article or those articles.

Allowance not payable

6. Outfit Allowance For Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General is not payable to an officer who is appointed honorary aide-de-camp to the Governor-General.

Application

7. This Determination applies in relation to an officer appointed as aide-de-camp to the Governor-General on or after 23 December 1980.

Transitional

8. The amount of Outfit Allowance For Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General payable to a member in respect of the period commencing on 23 December 1980 and ending on the day before the day on which this Determination is made, is the amount payable to him under this Determination less the amount payable to him under regulation 168 of the Naval Financial Regulations, regulation 238 of the Military Financial Regulations or regulation 575A or 648 of the Air Force Regulations in respect of that period.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 6 OF 1981

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 provides that the Minister may make determinations on conditions of service which are beneficial to members of the Defence Force.

This determination provides for payment of Outfit Allowance for Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General to officers of the Defence Force appointed as Aide-de-Camp to the Governor-General.

The determination consolidates legislative cover for the allowance under a tri-service determination made under section 58B of the Defence Act 1903, replacing the previous cover under regulation 168 of the Naval Financial Regulations, regulation 238 of the Military Financial Regulations and regulations 575A and 648 of the Air Force Regulations and increases the rates of the allowance payable with effect from 23 December 1980.
