Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903¹ (Amendment)

Medical and Dental Officers—Refresher Training Bounty

1. Determination 0712, Medical and Dental Officers—Refresher Training Bounty is amended by omitting from the definition of “military salary” in clause 2 “regulation 113 of the Naval Financial Regulations, regulation 28 of the Military Financial Regulations or regulation 556J of the Air Force Regulations”, and substituting “Determination 0104, Higher Duties Allowance, made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*”.

Maternity Leave

2. Determination 2604, Maternity Leave is amended—
- by omitting from sub-paragraph (a) (ii) of the definition of ‘salary’ in clause 2 “28,”;
 - by omitting from sub-paragraph (a) (iii) of the definition of ‘salary’ in clause 2 “, 111 and 113” and substituting “and 111”;
 - by omitting from sub-paragraph (a) (iv) of the definition of “salary” in clause 2 “556J,”;
 - by omitting “and” at the end of sub-paragraph (b) (viii) of the definition of “salary”;

- (e) by inserting "and" at the end of sub-paragraph (b) (ix) of the definition of "salary"; and
- (f) by inserting after sub-paragraph (b) (ix) of the definition of "salary" in clause 2 the following sub-paragraph:
 - "(x) Determination 0104, Higher Duties Allowance;"

Recreation Leave Bonus

3. Determination 2607, Recreation Leave Bonus is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (c) of clause 3 " , 108 and 113" and substituting "and 108";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) of clause 3 "28," and " , 556J";
- (c) by inserting "and" after paragraph (c) of clause 3;
- (d) by inserting in paragraph (d) of clause 3 "Determination 0104, Higher Duties Allowance," before "Determination 0106";
- (e) by omitting "and" at the end of paragraph (d) of clause 3; and
- (f) by omitting paragraph (e) of clause 3.

Long Service Leave

4. Determination 2701, Long Service Leave is amended—

- (a) by omitting paragraph (d) of clause 23 and substituting the following paragraph—
 - "(d) Determination 0104, Higher Duties Allowance, made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) of clause 24 "a provision specified in";
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (d) of clause 24 "a provision specified in";
- (d) by omitting from paragraph (b) of clause 25 "a provision specified in"; and
- (e) by omitting from clause 26 "a provision specified in" (wherever occurring).

Application

5. This Determination shall take effect on the day on which Determination 0104, Higher Duties Allowance is made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 3 OF 1982

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 provides that the Minister may make determinations on conditions of service which are beneficial to members of the Defence Force.

Determinations O712, Medical and Dental Officers - Refresher Training Bounty; 2604, Maternity Leave; 2607 Recreation Leave Bonus; and 2701 Long Service Leave all make references to various Service financial regulations which provide for payment of Higher Duties Allowance.

Determination O104, Higher Duties Allowance is a tri-Service determination which consolidates all the provisions relating to payment of Higher Duties Allowance to members who perform the duties of a higher position and replaces the Service financial regulations which previously provided for these provisions.

This determination makes appropriate consequential amendments to Determinations O712, 2604, 2607 and 2701.

The date of effect is the date Determination O104, Higher Duties Allowance is made.
