Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903¹ (Amendment)

District Allowance

1. Determination 0301, District Allowance, is amended—
 - (a) by omitting paragraph (a) from the definition of “isolated district” in clause 2 and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) a locality classified for the purposes of district allowance under the Determination made in respect of district allowance under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*; or”;
 - (b) by omitting from clause 4 “regulation 102 of the Public Service Regulations” and substituting “the Determination made in respect of district allowance under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*”; and
 - (c) by omitting from clause 9 “list referred to in regulation 102 of the Public Service Regulations” and substituting “Schedule referred to in the Determination made in respect of district allowance under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 5 OF 1982

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 provides that the Minister may make determinations on conditions of service which are beneficial to members of the Defence Force.

This Determination amends Determination 0301, District Allowance, to change references it makes to regulation 102 of the Public Service Regulations, which has been repealed, to read as references to a Determination on District Allowance made under section 82D of the Public Service Act, which replaces regulation 102.
