High Electricity Charges Allowance

1. Determination 0303, High Electricity Charges Allowance, is amended by omitting the definition of "specified locality" from clause 2 and substituting the following definition:

" 'specified locality' means Townsville or Cairns in Queensland or Exmouth in Western Australia;".

2. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 30 November 1981.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 6 OF 1982

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 provides that the Minister may make determinations on conditions of service which are beneficial to members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0303, High Electricity Charges Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to a member of the Defence Force who is faced with exceptionally high charges for the electricity supplied to the premises he normally occupies with his dependants. The allowance is paid to members living in specified remote localities.

This determination amends determination 0303, by including Cairns in Queensland as a specified locality for the payment of the allowance.

The date of effect is 30 November 1981.
