Recreation Leave Bonus

Determination 2607, Recreation Leave Bonus, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from the definition of “average weekly earnings” in clause 2 “the amount specified in the publication known as the Australian (Original) Average Weekly Earnings Per Employed Male Unit” and substituting “the Australian average weekly total earnings for all male employees”; and
- (b) by omitting the Schedule and substituting the following Schedule:

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 1 OF 1983

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service which are beneficial to members of the Defence Force.

Determination 2607 provides for the payment of recreation leave bonus to members of the Defence Force.

The maximum bonus payable is influenced by the amount specified as the "Australian (Original) Average Weekly Earnings Per Employed Male Unit" issued by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. As the name given to the figure representing male average weekly earnings and the basis of calculation of that figure were recently changed, this determination amends the definition of "average weekly earnings" in Determination 2607 to reflect this change.

The Schedule to Determination 2607 is amended to adopt the minor structural changes recently made to Schedule 9 of the Defence Force (Salaries) Regulations which deals with the salaries of members undergoing training and on which are based the descriptions of training capacities in this Schedule to Determination 2607.
