Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903¹ (Amendment)

Extra Risk Allowance

1. Determination 0208, Extra Risk Allowance, is amended—
- (a) by omitting clauses 1 and 2 and substituting the following clauses:

Citation

“1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 0208, Defence Force Extra Risk Insurance Expenses Allowance.¹”

Definitions

“2. In this Determination—

‘financial year’ means a period commencing on 1 July and ending on the following 30 June;

‘member’ means a member rendering service.”;

- (b) by adding at the end of clause 3 “, and the difference between those premiums shall be referred to as the extra risk premium”;
- (c) by omitting from clauses 3 and 4 “Extra Risk Allowance” (wherever occurring) and substituting “Defence Force Extra Risk Insurance Expenses Allowance”;

(d) by omitting paragraph 4 (a) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) equal to the sum of—

(i) the lesser of—

- A. the extra risk premium paid by the member for each insurance policy, other than a term insurance policy, held by the member; or
- B. an amount equal to 1.2 per cent of the value of each insurance policy, other than a term insurance policy, held by the member; and

(ii) the lesser of—

- A. the extra risk premium for each term insurance policy held by the member; or
- B. an amount equal to 5 times the basic premium per \$1,000 of the value of each term insurance policy held by the member; or”;

(e) by omitting clause 4 and substituting the following clause:

Amount of Allowance Payable

“4. Subject to clause 5 the amount of Defence Force Extra Risk Insurance Expenses Allowance payable in respect of a financial year is an amount equal to—

(a) the sum of—

(i) the lesser of—

- A. the extra risk premium paid by the member for each insurance policy, other than a term insurance policy, held by the member; or
- B. an amount equal to 1.2 per cent of the value of each insurance policy, other than a term insurance policy, held by the member; and

(ii) the lesser of—

- A. the extra risk premium for each term insurance policy held by the member; or
- B. an amount equal to 5 times the basic premium per \$1,000 of the value of each term insurance policy held by the member; or

(b) 1.2 per cent of twice the sum of salary and service allowance applicable to a member holding the rank of—

- (i) Lieutenant with 5 or more years' service—in respect of a member of the Navy;
- (ii) Captain with 5 or more years' service—in respect of a member of the Army; or
- (iii) Flight Lieutenant with 5 or more years' service—in respect of a member of the Air Force,

whichever is the lesser amount.”;

(f) by omitting from clause 5 “Extra Risk Allowance” and substituting “Defence Force Extra Risk Insurance Expenses Allowance”;

- (g) by adding at the end of paragraph 6 (c) the following paragraphs:
- “; (d) Director General, Naval Personal Services;
 - (e) Director of Naval Service Conditions;
 - (f) Deputy Director of Naval Service Conditions—Implementation;
 - (g) Director General Personnel Operations—Army;
 - (h) Director of Service Conditions—Army;
 - (i) Director of Personal Services B—Air Force”;
- (h) by omitting from clause 7 “Extra Risk Allowance” and substituting “Defence Force Extra Risk Insurance Expenses Allowance”.

Application

2. Paragraphs 1 (a), 1 (b), 1 (c), 1 (d), 1 (f), 1 (g) and 1 (h) of this Determination apply in relation to the payment of an insurance premium by a member on or after 1 January 1984.

3. Paragraph 1 (e) of this Determination applies in relation to the payment of an insurance premium by a member on or after 1 July 1984.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 38 OF 1983

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 provides that the Minister may make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0208, Extra Risk Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to a member of the Regular or Reserve Force who, as a result of the nature of his employment in the Defence Force, has paid a higher premium or premiums in respect of a life insurance policy or policies than he would have been required to pay if he had not been so employed.

This determination amends Determination 0208 by -

- a. creating new limits of reimbursement;
- b. including "term insurance policies" for the payment of the allowance;
- c. altering the method of calculation of the allowance;
- d. changing the title of the allowance; and
- e. extending the approving authority to certain members to approve excess claims.

The date of effect is 1 January 1984 except for the alteration to the method of calculation of the allowance which comes into effect on 1 July 1984.
