Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 0115, Special Allowance for Medical Officers and Dental Officers.¹

Definitions

2. In this Determination—

“dental officer” means an officer who is, or is eligible to be, registered as a dental practitioner under the laws of a State or Territory, and who is serving in—

- (a) a Dental Branch of the Navy;
- (b) the Royal Australian Army Dental Corps; or
- (c) a Medical Branch of the Air Force;

“medical officer” means an officer who is, or is eligible to be, registered as a medical practitioner under the laws of a State or Territory, and who is serving in—

- (a) a Medical Branch of the Navy;
- (b) the Royal Australian Army Medical Corps; or
- (c) a Medical Branch of the Air Force;

“member” means a member rendering continuous full-time service.

Rate of Allowance

3. An allowance is payable to a member who is a medical or dental officer in respect of service in the rank of—

- (a) Rear Admiral in the Navy;
- (b) Major General in the Army; or
- (c) Air Vice Marshal in the Air Force,

at the rate of \$2,764 per year.

Application

4. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 29 December 1983.
