## Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903

I, KIM CHRISTIAN BEAZLEY, the Minister of State for Aviation acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Defence, hereby make the following Determination under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

### Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 0698, Outfit (Relaxing of Uniform) Allowance.<sup>1</sup>

### Definitions

2. In this Determination—  
“officer” means an officer—

- (a) of the Naval Emergency Reserve Forces; or
- (b) of the Australian Naval Reserve,

rendering continuous full-time service of 12 months or less or rendering reserve service;

“reserve service” means service rendered by an officer other than service in respect of which he is entitled to be paid salary under the Defence Force (Salaries) Regulations.

### Approving Authority

3. The approving authority, for the purposes of clause 4, shall be the person from time to time holding or performing the duties of the office or appointment of Director General, Industrial Division, Service Conditions Branch in the Department of Defence.

**Outfit (Relacing of Uniform) Allowance**

**4. Where an officer—**

- (a) is promoted to a higher rank or is granted an acting higher rank;
- (b) is transferred from one branch to another branch;
- (c) is reverted from one rank to another rank; or
- (d) ceases to hold an acting rank,

is required as a consequence to have necessary alterations made to his uniform and is unable to have those alterations made at Commonwealth expense, an allowance called "Outfit (Relacing of Uniform) Allowance" is payable to the officer of such an amount as the approving authority approves having regard to—

- (e) the position to which the officer has been—
  - (i) promoted;
  - (ii) transferred; or
  - (iii) reverted; and
- (f) the cost incurred by the officer in having the necessary alterations made to his uniform.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 19 of 1984

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

This Determination provides for payment of an allowance called "Outfit (Relacing of Uniform) Allowance" to an officer of the Naval Emergency Reserve Forces or the Australian Naval Reserve rendering continuous full-time service of 12 months or less or rendering reserve service. The allowance reimburses such officers the costs incurred in having necessary alterations made to their uniform where those alterations were unable to be provided by the Commonwealth.

This determination replaces a determination made under regulation 168 of the Naval Financial Regulations.

Date of effect is the date of signature of the determination.
