Defence Act 1903¹ (Amendment)**

District Allowance

1. Determination 0301, District Allowance, is amended—

(a) by omitting from the table in clause 5 under the heading "Western Australia"—

"Broome C"
and substituting—

"Broome D"; and

(b) by inserting in the table in clause 5 under the heading "Northern Territory"—

"Katherine and Tindal C"
after—

"Gove (Nhulunbuy) D".

Medical and Dental Officers—Refresher Training Bounty

2. Determination 0712, Medical and Dental Officers—Refresher Training Bounty, is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraph (a) of the definition of "eligible person" in clause 2 and substituting the following paragraph:

"(a) was appointed to an arm of the Permanent Defence Force as a medical officer or a dental officer during a period ending two years after initial registration as a medical or dental practitioner;" and

- (b) by omitting sub-paragraph 5 (a) (iii) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(iii) the Director of Medical Plans—Air Force.”

Recreation Leave

3. Determination 2601, Recreation Leave, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-paragraphs 10 (c) (ii), 10 (d) (ii) and 10 (e) (ii) “less than 100 but more than 50” (twice occurring) and substituting “50 or more but less than 100”; and
(b) by inserting after clause 15A the following clause:

Other Remote Localities

“15B. Where a member serves in a locality that is not listed in column 1 of the table in clause 13, a reference in clause 13, 14, 15, 15A, 26 or 35 to—

- (a) the table; or
(b) a column of the table,

in clause 13 shall be read as a reference to—

- (c) the schedule; or
(d) an appropriate column of the schedule,

in a determination made in respect of a prescribed isolated district under sub-regulation (3) of regulation 49 of the Public Service Regulations.”

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 3 OF 1984

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0301, District Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members serving in localities classified by the Australian Public Service Board as being isolated districts.

This determination amends Determination 0301 to classify Katherine and Tindal as an isolated district and to change Broome to a Group D locality.

Determination 0712, Medical and Dental Officers - Refresher Training Bounty, provides for payment of a bounty to Short Service Commission medical and dental officers of the Defence Force to enable them to undertake a refresher training course at the completion of at least four years' full-time service as a medical or dental officer.

This determination amends Determination 0712 to clarify the intention of the definition of "eligible person" and to change the title of an approving authority in clause 5.

Determination 2601, Recreation Leave, provides for recreation leave for members of the Defence Force and clause 13 of that determination provides for leave additional to a member's normal recreation leave entitlement for service in remote localities.

This determination amends Determination 2601 to permit the automatic application to members of the Defence Force of Australian Public Service remote locality leave provisions in localities not listed in clause 13 and in which members do not usually serve, and to clarify policy intention when crediting a member with extra recreation leave for flying or flight duties undertaken during a leave year.

The date of effect of all amendments is the date of signature of the determination.
