Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903

Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as Determination 3995, Operation Anon Allowance.¹

Operation Anon Allowance

2. Subject to clause 3, a member of the Defence Force who—
- (a) is serving in those islands in the Pacific Ocean that form the nations of Kiribati, Nauru, Tuvalu, Fiji or the Kingdom of Tonga and the period of service is intended, by the appropriate authority within the arm of the Defence Force to which the member belongs, to be 6 months or less;
 - (b) is taking part in the Defence Force operation titled "Operation Anon"; and
 - (c) lives in the field or on board a RFMF minesweeper,
- shall be paid an Operation Anon Allowance at the rate of—
- (d) \$2.68 per day while he is accommodated on board a RFMF minesweeper; and
 - (e) \$3.48 per day while he is accommodated in the field.

3. The rate of Operation Anon Allowance specified in paragraph 2 (e) is not payable to a member in respect of a day for which he is entitled to Field Allowance under Determination 0209, Field Allowance, made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

Application

4. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 18 June 1984.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
DETERMINATION NO. 49 OF 1984
ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 3995, Operation Anon Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to a member of the Defence Force who is participating in the Defence Force operation titled "Operation Anon" in certain islands in the Pacific Ocean and who is living on board a minesweeper or in the field.

The date of effect is 18 June 1984.
