Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903¹ (Amendment)

Uniform Maintenance Allowance

1. Determination 0601, Uniform Maintenance Allowance, is amended—
- by omitting from paragraph 3 (a) "\$350" and substituting "\$360";
 - by omitting from paragraph 3 (b) "\$215" and substituting "\$221";
 - by omitting from paragraph 3 (c) "\$350" and substituting "\$360";
 - by omitting from paragraph 3 (d) "\$350" and substituting "\$360";
- and
- by omitting from paragraph 3 (e) "\$260" and substituting "\$268".

Initial Outfit Allowance—Female Members

2. Determination 0604, Initial Outfit Allowance—Female Members, is amended by omitting from clause 2 "\$124" and substituting "\$142".

Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments

3. Determination 0606, Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments, is amended by omitting the table from clause 3 and substituting the following table:

Insurance on Removal of Urgently Required Household Items

4. Determination 1906, Insurance on Removal of Urgently Required Household Items, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of “family” in clause 2 “a child of that member” (twice occurring) and substituting in each case “a child”;
- (b) by omitting from clause 6 all words after “amount not exceeding—” and substituting—
 - “(d) \$100; or
 - (e) 2% of the sum insured,
 whichever is the greater.”; and
- (c) by omitting from clause 9 “or where a member is living with another member in a *de facto* relationship” and substituting “or where a member is the *de facto* spouse of another member”.

Recreation Leave

5. Determination 2601, Recreation Leave, is amended by omitting from the table in clause 13—

“Alice Springs	4”
and substituting—	
“Alice Springs	5”.

Application

6. Clauses 1 and 2 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 1 December 1983.

7. Clause 3 of this Determination shall apply in relation to an appointment of an officer on or after 1 December 1983.

Transitional

8. A member or, where a member dies, a member of his family who insured urgently required household items which were removed during the period from and including 1 December 1983 to and including the day before the date on which this Determination is made shall be reimbursed in respect of the cost of the insurance the amount, if any, by which the amount payable under Determination 1906, as amended by paragraph 4 (b) of this Determination, exceeds the amount payable under Determination 1906 if paragraph 4 (b) of this Determination had not been made.

Interpretation

9. For the purposes of clause 8, Determination 1906 means Determination 1906, Insurance on Removal of Urgently Required Household Items, made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 5 OF 1984

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

This determination amends Determinations:

- a. 0601, Uniform Maintenance Allowance;
- b. 0604, Initial Outfit Allowance - Female Members;
- c. 0606, Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments; and
- d. 1906, Insurance on Removal of Urgently Required Household Items,

by increasing the rates at which the allowances are payable to reflect changes in the level of expenses incurred by members of the Defence Force for outfitting and maintaining uniforms and for insuring certain household items which are required urgently during a removal.

The dates of effect are:

- a. 1 December 1983 for a., b. and c. above; and
- b. 1 December 1983 for e. above if an increased entitlement is involved, otherwise the change is effective from the date on which the determination is signed.

This determination also amends Determination 2601, Recreation Leave, to increase the remote locality leave entitlement, for members serving in Alice Springs, from 4 to 5 days. The date of effect is the date on which the determination is signed.
