EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 59 OF 1984

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 3610, In Port Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to a member of the Defence Force who serves on a sea-going ship while that ship is visiting a foreign port.

This determination amends Determination 3610 to increase the rates of allowance payable for Kenya and Mauritius from 19 July 1984, and for Tanzania from 8 August 1984 and for the Philippines from 10 August 1984. It also introduces a rate of allowance for Coromo Islands, Madagascar, Réunion Island and Tuvalu from 9 August 1984; then increases the rate of allowance for Tuvalu from 4 September 1984 and decreases that rate from the date of signature of the determination.

Determination 3711, Settling In and Settling Out Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to a member of the Defence Force posted overseas for longer than 6 months who is required to reside temporarily in hotel accommodation at the overseas post.

This determination amends Determination 3711 to increase the rates of allowance payable for Kenya from 19 July 1984, Tanzania from 8 August 1984, and the Philippines from 10 August 1984.

Determination 3801, Representation Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to certain members of the Defence Force who are posted overseas for diplomatic, liaison or representational type duties.

This determination amends Determination 3801 to include amongst those members who are entitled to the allowance the Defence Adviser, South
