Transport Allowance

Determination 0404, Transport Allowance, is amended by omitting from clause 2 the definition of "member" and substituting the following definition:

" 'member' means a member rendering continuous full-time service;".

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 9 OF 1984

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0404 provides for the payment of Transport Allowance to members of the Defence Force to compensate them for using their private motor vehicles to travel to and from their place of duty in specified localities. This determination amends Determination 0404 to prevent payment of the allowance to members of the Reserve Forces when they are entitled to Attendance Allowance.
