EXPLANATORY STATEMENT  
DETERMINATION NO. 29 OF 1985  
ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE  
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determinations 3713, 3714, 3715, 3716 and 3724 provide respectively for payment of the following allowances to a member who is serving on duty overseas:

- a. Intermediate Term Duty Living Allowance;
- b. Overseas Living Out Allowance;
- c. Overseas Living In Allowance;
- d. Supplementary Living Allowance; and
- e. Child Allowance.

This determination amends Determinations 3713, 3714, 3715, 3716 and 3724 to increase from 7 February 1985 the rates of:

- a. Intermediate Term Duty Living Allowance payable to a member serving in Canada, France or the United States of America;
- b. Overseas Living Out Allowance payable to a member serving in Canada, China, Fiji, France, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Singapore, the Solomon Islands, the United States of America or Vanuatu;
- c. Overseas Living In Allowance payable to a member serving in Canada, Germany, Hong Kong or the United States of America;
- d. Supplementary Living Allowance payable to a member serving in Canada, Fiji, France, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Singapore, the Solomon Islands, the United States of America or Vanuatu; and

e. Child Allowance payable to a member serving in Canada, China, Fiji, France, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Singapore, the Solomon Islands, the United States of America or Vanuatu.

The determination also amends Determination 3716 to introduce from 20 December 1984 a Supplementary Living Allowance payable to certain members serving in Japan.
