## Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903<sup>1</sup> (Amendment)

I, KIM CHRISTIAN BEAZLEY, the Minister of State for Defence, hereby make the following Determination under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*.

### Airconditioning Allowance

1. Determination 0304, Airconditioning Allowance, is amended—

(a) by omitting from clause 2 the definition of “married quarter” and substituting the following definition:

“ ‘married quarter’ means—

- (a) a quarter owned or controlled by the Department of Defence and provided for the use of a member and his or her family as a residence;
- (b) a quarter owned or controlled by another Australian Commonwealth or State Public Service Department and provided, by arrangement between the last mentioned Department and the Department of Defence, for the use of a member and his or her family as a residence; or
- (c) where a quarter referred to in paragraph (a) or (b) is not available—a residence which is being rented by the member;” and

(b) by omitting from clause 4 “at Commonwealth expense, or installed at the member’s expense in circumstances similar to those where airconditioning facilities would be installed at Commonwealth expense”.

### Uniform Maintenance Allowance

2. Determination 0601, Uniform Maintenance Allowance, is amended—
- (a) by omitting from paragraph 3 (a) "\$360" and substituting "\$406";
  - (b) by omitting from paragraph 3 (b) "\$221" and substituting "\$249";
  - (c) by omitting from paragraph 3 (c) "\$360" and substituting "\$406";
  - (d) by omitting from paragraph 3 (d) "\$360" and substituting "\$406"; and
  - (e) by omitting from paragraph 3 (e) "\$268" and substituting "\$301".

### Initial Outfit Allowance—Female Members

3. Determination 0604, Initial Outfit Allowance—Female Members, is amended by omitting from clause 2 "\$142" and substituting "\$215".

### Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments

4. Determination 0606, Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments, is amended by omitting the table from clause 3 and substituting the following table:

5. Clause 1 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member on or after 1 February 1984.

6. Clauses 2, 3 and 4 of this Determination shall apply in relation to the appointment or enlistment of a member on or after 1 December 1984.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 4 OF 1984

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

This determination amends Determinations:

- a. 0601, Uniform Maintenance Allowance;
- b. 0604, Initial Outfit Allowance - Female Members;  
and
- c. 0606, Outfit Allowance for Special Appointments,

by increasing the rates at which the allowances are payable to reflect changes in the level of expenses incurred by members of the Defence Force for outfitting themselves with, and maintaining, uniforms and other clothing requirements. The date of effect is 1 December 1984.

The determination also amends Determination 0304, Airconditioning Allowance, to extend payment of the allowance to members of the Defence Force who, because married quarters are not available in specified localities, are required to occupy rented accommodation in which airconditioners are fitted. The date of effect is 1 February 1984.
