Salary of Permanent Force Members

Determination 0101, Salary of Permanent Force Members, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from clauses 74, 75 and 76 “or 10” and substituting “, 10 or 12” in each case;
- (b) by omitting from item 9 of Schedule 7 “or 8” and substituting “, 8 or 12”; and
- (c) by inserting after item 11 of Schedule 7 the following item:

“12 Staff cadets of the Army and officer cadets of the Air Force undergoing an 18 month course of military studies 11,948”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
DETERMINATION NO. 49 OF 1985
ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE
UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0101, Salary of Permanent Force Members, provides the rates and conditions for the payment of salary to members of the Defence Force who are rendering continuous full-time service.

This determination amends Determination 0101 by adding a new item to Schedule 7 to provide a rate of salary for members who are undergoing a new 18 month course of military studies. The determination also makes amendments to clauses 74, 75 and 76 to provide for the maintenance of a higher rate of salary where a member undergoing the new 18 month course of study was previously a member of the Defence Force.

The date of effect is the date of making of the determination.
