## Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903<sup>1</sup> (Amendment)

### Resident Medical Officers—Additional Salary

1. Determination 0116, Resident Medical Officers—Additional Salary, is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraph 2 (a) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) ‘hospital remuneration’ means—

- (i) the salary or remuneration payable from time to time to a medical officer by the owner of the hospital at which that officer is undergoing a period of compulsory residency;
- (ii) an allowance, if any, payable by that owner to that officer in respect of circumstances which are similar to those for which an allowance would be payable under Determination 0301, District Allowance, Determination 0302, Woomera Allowance or Determination 0306, Broken Hill Allowance; and
- (iii) any allowances payable by that owner to that officer in respect of matters, occurrences or duties for which the officer is not entitled to be reimbursed or remunerated by the Commonwealth,

but does not include payment in lieu of leave;”;

- (b) by omitting paragraph 2 (c) and substituting the following paragraph:
- “(c) ‘military remuneration’ means—
- (i) the total of salary payable from time to time to a medical officer under—
    - (A) paragraph 7 (1) (aa) of the Defence Force (Salaries) Regulations as in force from time to time prior to 31 December 1984; and
    - (B) paragraph 36 (b) of Determination 0101, Salary of Permanent Force Members;
  - (ii) the allowance payable from time to time to that officer under Determination 0201, Service Allowance; and
  - (iii) where a corresponding allowance is included in the hospital remuneration payable to the officer, the allowance payable from time to time to the officer under Determination 0301, District Allowance, Determination 0302, Woomera Allowance or Determination 0306, Broken Hill Allowance;”;
- (c) by omitting from clause 3 “hospital salary” and “military salary” and substituting “hospital remuneration” and “military remuneration” respectively; and
- (d) by omitting from clause 4 “hospital salary” (twice occurring) and “military salary” and substituting “hospital remuneration” and “military remuneration” respectively.

#### **Travelling Allowance**

2. Determination 0401, Travelling Allowance, is amended by inserting after sub-paragraph 4 (a) (i) (F) the following sub-paragraph:

“(Fa) Deputy Director Naval Service Conditions—Implementation;”.

#### **Insurance on Removal Overseas**

3. Determination 2102, Insurance on Removal Overseas, is amended by omitting from clause 9 “\$2,000” and substituting “\$2,400”.

#### **Application**

4. Clause 3 of this Determination shall apply in respect of a premium for insurance cover in relation to a member who proceeds overseas on or after 23 December 1983.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 9 OF 1985

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0116, Resident Medical Officers - Additional Salary, provides for the payment of additional salary to a medical officer of the Defence Force who is undergoing a period of compulsory residency at a hospital. The additional salary is the amount by which the officer's remuneration earned while employed at the hospital exceeds his or her entitlements as a member of the Defence Force.

This Determination amends Determination 0116 to include District Allowance, Woomera Allowance and Broken Hill Allowance as part of "military salary" and corresponding allowances which may be paid by the hospital as "hospital salary" for the purposes of this determination. This will include, as additional salary, the amounts by which the hospital allowances exceed the similar Defence Force allowances.

Determination 0401, Travelling Allowance, provides for payment of Travelling Allowance to members who are authorized to travel on duty or posting within Australia.

This Determination amends Determination 0401 by including the Deputy Director Naval Service Conditions - Implementation as an approving authority.

Determination 2102, Insurance on Removal Overseas, provides for the limited reimbursement of insurance premiums paid by a member of the Defence Force for baggage and household items removed to or from the overseas locality when posted overseas.

This Determination amends Determination 2102 by increasing the limit of permissible insurance cover from \$2000 to \$2400 for a member posted overseas for a period which is 6 months or less. The date of effect for the increase is 23 December 1983.
