Travelling Allowance

1. Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, is amended by omitting from sub-paragraph (b) (ii) of the definition of "other countries" in clause 2 "Burma".

2. Schedule 1 to Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, is amended as set out in the following table:

4. The table in clause 5 of Determination 3610, In Port Allowance, is amended by omitting the entry relating to Burma and substituting—

5. Schedule 2 to Determination 3711, Settling In and Settling Out Allowance, is amended by omitting the entry relating to Burma and substituting—

Education Assistance Overseas

6. Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, is amended by—

- (a) omitting from paragraph 10 (d) "other than a member serving with the British Army of the Rhine"; and
- (b) inserting after clause 20 in Division 4 the following clause:

"20A. Where a member to whom clause 6 refers is serving in the Federal Republic of Germany with the British Army of the Rhine and it is necessary for the member to transport in the member's private motor vehicle one or more children between the member's place of residence and a pre-school or pre-schools which are situated outside a radius of 5 kilometres from that place of residence, the amount of—

- (a) in the case of a member who has access to motor fuel at a privileged price—Deutschmarks 0.135; or
- (b) in any other case—Deutschmarks 0.27,

in respect of each whole kilometre of that radius which exceeds 5 kilometres in connection with the transport to the pre-school or, in the case of more than one pre-school, the pre-school which is farthest from that residence, shall be deemed to be an education expense for the purpose of clause 7."

Application

7. Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, as amended by clauses 1 and 3 and item 1 of the table in clause 2 shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 22 January 1986.

8. Determination 3711, Settling In and Settling Out Allowance, as amended by clause 5 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 22 January 1986.

9. Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, as amended by clause 6 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 1 January 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 22 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, Determination 3610, In Port Allowance and Determination 3711, Settling In and Settling Out Allowance, provide allowances which reimburse the additional travelling costs incurred by members of the Defence Force serving overseas.

Clauses 1, 2, 3 and 7 of this determination amend Determination 3601 to increase and introduce from 22 January 1986 certain rates of Travelling Allowance payable to members serving on short term duty in Burma and also to decrease certain other rates payable in Burma with effect from the date of signature of this determination.

Clause 4 of this determination amends Determination 3610 to decrease the rates of this allowance payable to members serving in Burma with effect from the date of signature of this determination.

Clause 5 of this determination amends Determination 3711 to increase, with effect from 22 January 1986, the rates of this allowance payable to members serving in Burma.

Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, provides for financial assistance to a member of the Defence Force who is posted overseas on long term duty and incurs certain costs in educating a child overseas.

Clause 6 and 9 of this determination amend Determination 3725 to allow for the reimbursement of transport costs incurred by members of the Defence Force serving on duty with the British Army of the Rhine while using their private motor vehicles to transport their children to and from pre-schools. The change is effective from 1 January 1986.
