Education Assistance Overseas

1. Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from the end of paragraph 10 (n) "or"; and
 - (b) by inserting after paragraph 10 (o) the following word and paragraph:
"; or (oa) Vanuatu,".

2. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 1 February 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 27 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, provides for payment of financial assistance to a member of the Defence Force who is posted overseas for more than 6 months and incurs certain costs in the education of a child overseas.

This determination amends Determination 3725 to allow for the reimbursement of transport costs, up to an amount of \$A115 per year, incurred by a member who is serving in Vanuatu and who uses his private motor vehicle to transport his or her child/children to and from school when no school bus is available. The date of effect is 1 February 1986.
