Determination under Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903' (Amendment)

Airconditioning Allowance

1. Determination 0304, Airconditioning Allowance, is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraph (c) from the definition of "married quarter" in clause 2 and substituting the following paragraph:

"(c) where a quarter referred to in paragraph (a) or (b) is not available to a member—a residence in respect of which the member is entitled to the payment of an allowance under Determination 0503, Temporary Rental Allowance, made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*";

(b) by inserting after clause 4 the following clause:

"4A. A reference in clause 4 to a 'married quarter' shall not, in respect of the Katherine locality or the Tindal locality, include a reference to a residence referred to in paragraph (c) of the definition of 'married quarter' in clause 2.";

(c) by inserting in the table in clause 9 after the entry relating to Karratha the following entry:

"Katherine	September, April	—	October, November, December, January, February, March"; and

(d) by inserting in the table in clause 9 after the entry relating to Port Hedland the following entry:

"Tindal	September, April	—	October, November, December, January, February, March".

Recreation Leave

2. The table in clause 13 of Determination 2601, Recreation Leave, is amended—

(a) by inserting after the entry relating to Karratha the following entry:

"Katherine 5";

and

(b) by inserting after the entry relating to Port Hedland the following entry:

"Tindal 5".

Application

3. Paragraphs 1 (b), 1 (c), 1 (d) and 2 (b) of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 22 November 1985.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 29 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0304, Airconditioning Allowance provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Defence Force serving in specified localities to reimburse the cost of operating airconditioning facilities fitted to their married quarters.

Determination 2601, Recreation Leave, provides for the credit of recreation leave to members of the Defence Force. The determination also provides for additional recreation leave to be credited to members serving in certain designated remote localities.

Paragraph 1(a) of this determination amends, with effect from the date of signature of this determination, the definition of "married quarter" in clause 2 of Determination 0304 to make it clearer that, before Airconditioning Allowance is payable for private rented accommodation, there must be an entitlement to Temporary Rental Allowance under Determination 0503 in respect of that accommodation.

Paragraphs 1(b), 1(c) and 1(d) and clause 3 of this determination amend, with effect from 22 November 1985, Determination 0304 to include Katherine and Tindal as localities in respect of which Airconditioning Allowance is payable.

Clauses 2 and 3 of this determination amend Determination 2601 to include Katherine and Tindal as remote localities within Australia for which there is an additional recreation leave entitlement of 5 days per year for members serving in these localities. The date of effect of the amendment to Determination 2601 with respect to Tindal is 22 November 1985 and with respect to Katherine is the date of signature of this determination.
