**Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments**

Determination 0606, Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments, is amended—

(a) by omitting from the table in clause 3—

"1 morning dress. . . . .	644",
"2 evening collars . . . . .	12", and
"1 white bow tie. . . . .	6";

(b) by inserting after "where a member is serving in a position" in clause 4 " , other than the position referred to in clause 3,";

(c) by inserting after clause 4 the following clause:

"4A. Subject to clause 7, where an officer—

(a) is appointed aide-de-camp to the Governor-General; and

(b) in the opinion of the approving authority, the articles of clothing or luggage specified in column 1 of the table in clause 3 are inadequate to satisfactorily perform the duties of that appointment,

the approving authority may approve the payment of an amount which will meet the reasonable cost of—

(c) purchasing; or

- (d) where it is practicable and it is expected to be cheaper over the period during which the officer is performing the duties of the appointment, the hire, of additional articles of clothing or luggage.”;
- (d) by omitting “clause 4” from clause 5 and substituting “clauses 4 and 4A”; and
- (e) by omitting “or clause 4” from paragraph 6 (e) and substituting “, 4 or 4A”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION No. 32 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0606, Outfit Allowance For Special Appointments, provides for the payment of a clothing and equipment allowance to members of the Defence Force appointed as aides-de-camp to the Governor-General, or for other special appointments such as aides or equerries.

Clause 3 of Determination 0606 lists certain items of clothing and luggage in respect of which an aide-de-camp to the Governor-General may be paid an allowance. Paragraph (a) of this determination omits items of clothing from that list of permissible purchases.

This determination also amends Determination 0606 by inserting a new clause 4A to allow an approving authority to approve the payment of an amount that will meet the cost of either purchasing or hiring additional items of clothing or luggage where that approving authority considers that the articles of clothing or luggage specified in clause 3 of Determination 0606 are inadequate for an aide-de-camp to the Governor-General to satisfactorily perform the duties of that position. Other amendments are made as a consequence of inserting this new clause.

The date of effect of this determination is the date on which it is signed.
