Overseas Living Out Allowance

1. Subject to clause 2 of this Determination, Schedule 2 to Determination 3714, Overseas Living Out Allowance, is amended by omitting the entry opposite to item 19 and substituting—

2. Where a member—

- (a) served in Papua New Guinea during the period from and including 6 March 1986 to and including 28 May 1986; and
- (b) was entitled to an annual rate of Overseas Living Out Allowance in respect of all or part of that period,

the member shall be entitled to an annual rate of Overseas Living Out Allowance in accordance with the following table for—

- (c) the number of days, commencing on 29 May 1986, which is equal to the number of days during the period from and including 6 March 1986 to and including 28 May 1986 in respect of which he or she was entitled to the rate referred to in paragraph (b); or

the member shall be entitled to an annual rate of Supplementary Living Allowance in accordance with the following table for—

- (c) the number of days, commencing on 29 May 1986, which is equal to the number of days during the period from and including 6 March 1986 to and including 28 May 1986 in respect of which he or she was entitled to the rate referred to in paragraph (b); or
- (d) the number of days, commencing on 29 May 1986, in respect of which the member remains entitled to an annual rate of Supplementary Living Allowance in respect of service in Papua New Guinea at other than the High Commission,

5. For the purposes of this Determination, "accompanied", "allowance group" and "unaccompanied" have the same meaning as in Determination 3714, Overseas Living Out Allowance, or Determination 3716, Supplementary Living Allowance, whichever is appropriate. 360p

6. Determination 3714, Overseas Living Out Allowance, as amended by clause 1 of this Determination, shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 29 May 1986.

7. Determination 3716, Supplementary Living Allowance, as amended by clause 3 of this Determination, shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 29 May 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO.33 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determinations 3714 and 3716 provide respectively for the payment of Overseas Living Out Allowance and Supplementary Living Allowance to a member who is serving overseas. The allowances are intended to enable members to maintain a standard of living comparable to their standard in Australia by reimbursing the additional costs incurred because of their service overseas.

Clauses 1, 3, 6 and 7 of this determination amend Determinations 3714 and 3716 by decreasing the rates of Overseas Living Out Allowance and some of the rates of Supplementary Living Allowance payable to a member serving on duty in Papua New Guinea on or after 29 May 1986.

Clauses 2 and 4 of this determination apply to those members who served in Papua New Guinea during some or all of the period from 6 March 1986 to 28 May 1986 and were entitled to the rates of Overseas Living Out Allowance and Supplementary Living Allowance applicable for that period. The clauses provide, in most cases, for lower rates to be paid for so much of the period from 29 May 1986 to 20 August 1986 as members remain entitled to these allowances for service in Papua New Guinea.

Clause 5 of the determination defines the meaning of several terms used in the tables in clauses 2 and 4.
