### Antarctic Allowance

1. Determination 0305, Antarctic Allowance, is amended—
  - (a) by omitting from paragraph 2 (a) "\$4,900" and substituting "\$5,218"; and
  - (b) by omitting from paragraph 2 (b) "\$2,700" and substituting "\$2,875".

### Application

2. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 4 April 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 35 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination O305 provides for the payment of Antarctic Allowance as financial recompense for the difficult climatic and accommodation conditions a member of the Defence Force endures whilst posted for duty or serving in Antarctica as part of an official Australian expedition to the region.

This determination amends Determination O305 to increase the rates of this allowance with effect from 4 April 1986.
