**Travelling Allowance**

1. Determination 0401, Travelling Allowance, is amended—

(a) by omitting the table from clause 8 and substituting the following table:

- (b) by omitting from the table in clause 9 “36.80” and “30.55”, and substituting “38.40” and “31.90” respectively;
- (c) by omitting from clause 10 “\$8.90” and “\$6.70”, and substituting “\$9.65” and “\$7.25” respectively; and
- (d) by omitting from clause 11 “\$8.90” and substituting “\$9.65”.

### Temporary Accommodation Allowance

2. Determination 0504, Temporary Accommodation Allowance, is amended by omitting Schedule 2 and substituting the following Schedule:

### Meal Allowance

3. Determination 0506, Meal Allowance, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-paragraph 10 (a) (ii) "\$7.85" and substituting "\$8.10";
- (b) by omitting from sub-paragraph 10 (a) (iii) "\$9.90" and substituting "\$10.75";
- (c) by omitting from sub-paragraph 10 (b) (ii) "\$7.85" and substituting "\$8.10";
- (d) by omitting from sub-paragraph 10 (b) (iii) "\$9.15" and substituting "\$9.75"; and
- (e) by omitting from paragraph 10 (c) "\$7.85" and substituting "\$8.10".

### Application

4. This Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 7 May 1986.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 39. OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0401, Travelling Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Defence Force who are authorised to travel on duty or posting within Australia.

Determination 0504, Temporary Accommodation Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance where a member and family are moved at Commonwealth expense from one locality to another locality within Australia and, because of that move, it is necessary to accommodate the member and family in a house of accommodation such as a hotel or motel for a short period.

Determination 0506, Meal Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to enable members of the Defence Force to purchase meals where, for service reasons, the Commonwealth cannot provide them with the meals to which they are entitled or where they are required to work extended or unusual hours.

This determination amends Determinations 0401, 0504 and 0506 to increase most rates of these allowances, with effect from 7 May 1986.
