 - (b) by omitting from paragraph 3 (b) "\$3.50" and substituting "\$3.65";
 - (c) by omitting from paragraph 3 (c) "\$4.70" and substituting "\$4.85";and
 - (d) by omitting from paragraph 3 (d) "\$6.50" and substituting "\$6.75".

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 49 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0499, Attendance Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to a member of the Reserve Forces to assist with the cost of travel between his or her usual place of residence and his or her place of duty.

Clause 1 of this determination amends Determination 0499 to increase the rates of this allowance with effect from 14 November 1985.
