Salary of Permanent Force Members

1. Determination 0101, Salary of Permanent Force Members, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from clause 19 "serviced" and substituting "service";
- (b) by omitting from item 19 of Schedule 8 "or" (third occurring) and substituting "of";
- (c) by omitting from item 24 of Schedule 8 "or" (fourth occurring) and substituting "of";
- (d) by omitting from item 25 of Schedule 8 "or" (third occurring) and substituting "of"; and
- (e) by omitting from item 35 of Schedule 8 "30, or 33" and substituting "30 or 33".

Temporary Accommodation Allowance

2. Determination 0504, Temporary Accommodation Allowance, is amended by inserting in clause 6 "11," after "4,".

Travelling Allowance

3. Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, is amended by omitting from Schedule 1 the entry relating to Western Samoa and substituting the following entry:

(c) by inserting after clause 23 the following clause:

"23A. Where a member to whom clause 6 refers is serving in Indonesia and incurs costs in transporting a child by school bus, other than the compulsory costs referred to in paragraph 7 (i), those costs shall be deemed to be an education expense for the purposes of clause 7."; and

- (d) by omitting from clause 31 "\$285" and substituting "\$255".

Medical and Hospital Expenses of a Member's Family Overseas

10. Determination 3737, Medical and Hospital Expenses of a Member's Family Overseas, is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the definition of "qualified medical practitioner" in clause 2 the following definition:
 " 'senior Service representative' means the senior Naval, Army or Air Force Officer, as the case may be, representing the Department of Defence at an overseas post;";
- (b) by inserting before "home nursing" (first occurring) in sub-paragraph 3 (d) (viii) "in respect of a member other than a member serving in the Philippines";
- (c) by inserting before "employment" in sub-paragraph 3 (d) (ix) "in respect of a member other than a member serving in the Philippines";
- (d) by omitting "or" from the end of sub-paragraph 3 (d) (x);
- (e) by inserting after sub-paragraph 3 (d) (xi) the following sub-paragraphs:
 "(xii) in respect of a member serving in the Philippines, home nursing unless otherwise approved by the approving authority having regard to—
 (A) expert medical advice as to the necessity for home nursing; and
 (B) whether hospitalization would otherwise have been necessary; or
 (xiii) in respect of a member serving in the Philippines, employment of special nurses at a hospital, unless otherwise approved by the approving authority having regard to expert medical advice as to the necessity for the attendance of special nurses;"; and
- (f) by omitting paragraphs 7 (a) and 7 (b) and substituting the following paragraphs:
 "(a) clauses 14, 19, 20 and 21, sub-paragraphs 3 (d) (viii), 3 (d) (ix), 3 (d) (x) and 9 (c) (iii), the approving authority shall be the person from time to time holding or performing the duties of the office or appointment in the Department of Defence titled Director General, Industrial Division, Service Conditions Branch; and
 (b) clauses 10, 12, 13 and 14, paragraph 9 (b), sub-paragraphs 3 (d) (xii), 3 (d) (xiii) and 9 (c) (i), the approving authority shall be the Head of Post, the Head of Mission or the senior Service representative."

Car Insurance Allowance

“79A. Subject to clause 85, where a member expends an annual amount on third party and comprehensive car insurance in excess of the amount, in relation to his or her allowance group, specified in column 2 of the following table, the member shall be paid a Car Insurance Allowance in accordance with an annual amount equal to the lesser of that excess amount or the amount, in relation to his or her allowance group, specified in column 3 of the following table:

“80. Where a member to whom clause 79 applies is accompanied by a child or children who are less than 6 years of age and who travelled to the overseas post, or will travel from the overseas post, at Commonwealth expense and the member—

- (a) employs a person, or persons, for the purpose of child minding services in addition to the person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs the expenditure referred to in clause 79; or

- (b) uses a person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs expenditure referred to in clause 79, for the purpose of child minding services,
the member shall be paid a Child Minding Allowance of an amount equal to—
- (c) where the member employs a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (a) the sum of—
- (i) the lesser of the costs per month which the member incurs in respect of wages for child minding services, or Rupiahs 41,000 per month; and
 - (ii) the lesser of the costs per annum, other than for wages, which the member incurs in respect of child minding services, or Rupiahs 217,000 per annum; or
- (d) where the member uses a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (b) the sum of—
- (i) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per month for wages for child minding services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends, in respect of a month, on wages for child minding services, or Rupiahs 41,000 per month; and
 - (ii) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per annum, other than for wages, in respect of child minding services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends on child minding services, other than for wages, or Rupiahs 217,000 per annum,

but that allowance shall not exceed an annual amount of Rupiahs 529,000.”;

- (e) by omitting clause 81 and substituting the following clause:

“81. Where a member to whom clause 79 applies, resides in Jakarta and—

- (a) employs a person, or persons, for the purpose of driving services in addition to the person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs the expenditure referred to in clause 79; or
- (b) uses a person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs expenditure referred to in clause 79, for the purpose of driving services,

the member shall be paid a Driver Allowance of an amount equal to—

- (c) where the member employs a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (a) the sum of—
- (i) the lesser of the costs per month which the member incurs in respect of wages for driving services, or Rupiahs 80,000 per month; and

- (ii) the lesser of the costs per annum, other than for wages, which the member incurs in respect of driving services, or Rupiahs 281,250 per annum; or
- (d) where the member uses a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (b) the sum of—
 - (i) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per month for wages for driving services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends, in respect of a month, on wages for driving services, or Rupiahs 80,000 per month; and
 - (ii) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per annum, other than for wages, in respect of driving services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends on driving services, other than for wages, or Rupiahs 281,250 per annum.”;
- (f) by omitting from clause 82 “or Singapore,” (twice occurring);
- (g) by omitting from clause 82 “as the case may be,”;
- (h) by omitting from paragraph 83 (d) “197,100” and substituting “235,000”;
- (i) by omitting clause 84 and substituting the following clauses:
 - “84. Subject to clause 85, where a member to whom clause 79 applies—
 - (a) employs a person, or persons, for the purpose of nightwatch services in addition to the person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs the expenditure referred to in clause 79; or
 - (b) uses a person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs expenditure referred to in clause 79, for the purpose of nightwatch services,the member shall be paid a Watchman Allowance of an amount equal to—
 - (c) where the member employs a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (a) the sum of—
 - (i) the lesser of the costs per month which the member incurs in respect of wages for nightwatch services, or Rupiahs 38,000 per month; and
 - (ii) the lesser of the costs per annum, other than for wages, which the member incurs in respect of nightwatch services, or Rupiahs 197,250 per annum; or
 - (d) where the member uses a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (b) the sum of—
 - (i) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per month for wages for nightwatch services,

which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends, in respect of a month, on wages for nightwatch services, or Rupiahs 38,000 per month; and

- (ii) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per annum, other than for wages, in respect of nightwatch services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends on nightwatch services, other than for wages, or Rupiahs 197,250 per annum.

“84A. Subject to clause 85, where a member to whom clause 79 applies—

- (a) employs a person, or persons, for the purpose of daywatch services in addition to the person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs the expenditure referred to in clause 79; or
- (b) uses a person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs expenditure referred to in clause 79, for the purpose of daywatch services,

the member shall be paid a Watchman Allowance of an amount equal to—

- (c) where the member employs a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (a) the sum of—
 - (i) the lesser of the costs per month which the member incurs in respect of wages for daywatch services, or Rupiahs 38,000 per month; and
 - (ii) the lesser of the costs per annum, other than for wages, which the member incurs in respect of daywatch services, or Rupiahs 197,250 per annum; or
- (d) where the member uses a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (b) the sum of—
 - (i) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per month for wages for daywatch services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends, in respect of a month, on wages for daywatch services, or Rupiahs 38,000 per month; and
 - (ii) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per annum, other than for wages, in respect of daywatch services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 79, that the member expends on daywatch services, other than for wages, or Rupiahs 197,250 per annum.”;
- (j) by inserting before paragraph 85 (a) the following paragraph:
 - “(aa) under clause 79A—
 - (i) in respect of more than one motor vehicle; and

(ii) unless the approving authority is satisfied that the excess costs are reasonable having regard to the type of motor vehicle owned by the member and the standard of motor vehicle provided for in calculating the amount of Overseas Living Out Allowance payable to the member.”;

(k) by omitting clause 132 and substituting the following clause:

Prior Expenditure Required for Payment of Child Minding Allowance, Driver Allowance, Gardening Assistance Allowance and Household Assistance Allowance

“132. This clause applies to a member who employs a person, or persons, for the purpose of child minding or driving services, gardening assistance or household assistance and who expends an amount per annum in respect of employing that person, or those persons, equal to or greater than the amount specified, in relation to his or her allowance group, in the following table for an accompanied member or an unaccompanied member, as the case may be:

(l) by inserting after clause 132 the following clause:

Child Minding Allowance

“132A. Where a member to whom clause 132 applies is accompanied by a child or children who are less than 6 years of age and who travelled to the overseas post, or will travel from the overseas post, at Commonwealth expense and the member—

- (a) employs a person, or persons, for the purpose of child minding services in addition to the person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs the expenditure referred to in clause 132; or
- (b) uses a person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs expenditure referred to in clause 132, for the purpose of child minding services,

the member shall be paid a Child Minding Allowance of an amount equal to the lesser of—

- (c) where the member employs a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (a)—the lesser of the costs which the member incurs per annum in respect of child minding services, or Peso 7,200 per annum; or

- (d) where the member uses a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (b)—the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per annum in respect of child minding services which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 132, that the member expends on child minding services, or Peso 7,200 per annum.”;
- (m) by omitting clause 133 and substituting the following clause:
 “133. Subject to clause 138, where a member to whom clause 132 applies—
- (a) employs a person, or persons, for the purpose of driving services in addition to the person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs the expenditure referred to in clause 132; or
- (b) uses a person, or persons, in respect of whom the member incurs expenditure referred to in clause 132, for the purpose of driving services,
- the member shall be paid a Driver Allowance in accordance with an amount equal to—
- (c) where the member employs a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (a) the sum of—
- (i) the lesser of the costs per month which the member incurs in respect of wages for driving services, or Peso 1,300 per month; and
- (ii) the lesser of the costs per annum, other than for wages, which the member incurs in respect of driving services, or Peso 6,300 per annum; or
- (d) where the member uses a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (b) the sum of—
- (i) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per month for wages for driving services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 132, that the member expends, in respect of a month, on wages for driving services, or Peso 1,300 per month; and
- (ii) the lesser of the amount, if any, which the member incurs per annum, other than for wages, in respect of driving services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 132, that the member expends on driving services other than for wages, or Peso 6,300 per annum.”;
- (n) by omitting from clause 134 “6” and substituting “12”;
- (o) by omitting from clause 135 “residence with medium or large grounds” and substituting “house”;
- (p) by omitting paragraphs 135 (c) and 135 (d) and substituting the following paragraphs:

- “(c) where the member—
- (i) employs a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (a)—the costs which the member incurs per annum in respect of gardening services; and
 - (ii) uses a person, or persons, referred to in paragraph (b)—the amount, if any, which the member incurs per annum in respect of gardening services, which exceeds so much of the amount specified in the table in clause 132 that the member expends on gardening services; or
- (d) where the member resides in a house with grounds that are:
- (i) small—Peso 4,000 per annum;
 - (ii) medium—Peso 7,200 per annum; or
 - (iii) large—Peso 8,800 per annum.”;

(q) by omitting from paragraph 136 (c) “550” and substituting “700”;

(r) by omitting from paragraph 136 (d) “4,550” and substituting “9,250”;

and

(s) by omitting clause 137 and substituting the following clause:

“137. Where a member who is not entitled to an allowance under clause 133 incurs costs for parking his or her motor vehicle, the member shall be paid a Parking Allowance in accordance with a weekly amount equal to the lesser of the costs which he or she so incurs per working week or the amount charged per week by the Velaro Car Park, Manila.”.

Application

12. Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, as amended by clause 3 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 8 March 1985.

13. Determination 3610, In Port Allowance, as amended by clause 4 of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 8 March 1985.

14. Determination 3714, Overseas Living Out Allowance, as amended by paragraph 5 (b) of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 18 April 1985.

15. Determination 3718, Overseas Rental and Utilities Allowance, as amended by paragraphs 7 (b), 7 (c), 7 (d) and 7 (h) of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 20 September 1984.

16. Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas, as amended by paragraph 9 (c) of this Determination shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 20 September 1984.

17. Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, as amended by—

- (a) paragraph 11 (s) of this Determination—shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 29 March 1985;
- (b) paragraph 11 (n) of this Determination—shall apply in relation to service by a member from and including 8 April 1985; and

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 5 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0101, Salary of Permanent Force Members, prescribes the rates of salary payable to members of the Defence Force who are rendering continuous full-time service.

Determination 0504, Temporary Accommodation Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance where a member of the Defence Force and his or her family are moved at Commonwealth expense from one locality to another in Australia and, because of that move, it is necessary to accommodate the member and family in a hotel or motel for a short period.

Clauses 1 and 2 of this determination amend Determination 0101 and Determination 0504 respectively by making minor textual corrections with effect from the date of signature of this determination.

Determination 3601, Travelling Allowance, Determination 3610, In Port Allowance, Determination 3714, Overseas Living Out Allowance Determination 3718, Overseas Rental and Utilities Allowance, Determination 3725, Education Assistance Overseas and Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, provide allowances to members of the Defence Force who serve on duty overseas. The allowances reimburse the travelling costs of those members or enable them to maintain a standard of living comparable to their standard in Australia by reimbursing the additional costs incurred because of their service overseas.

Clauses 3 and 12 of this determination amend Determination 3601 to introduce, with effect from 8 March 1985, short term duty Travelling Allowance payable to members serving in Western Samoa, in a place other than Apia.

Clauses 4 and 13 of this determination amend Determination 3610 to increase, with effect from 8 March 1985, In Port Allowance payable to members serving in Kiribati and Western Samoa.

Clauses 5 and 14 of this determination amend Determination 3714 to decrease, with effect from 18 April 1985, the amount which a member serving in Indonesia must contribute for private use of official transport; and to increase, with effect from date of signature of this determination, the contribution rate for a member serving in the Philippines and for a member serving in Indonesia who use official transport to and from work.

Clauses 7 and 15 of this determination amend Determination 3718 to increase, with effect from 20 September 1984, Overseas Rental and Utilities Allowance payable to members serving in Indonesia and the Philippines to restrict, with effect from date of signature of this determination, the application of the rent ceilings for Indonesia to members residing in Jakarta; and to make minor textual amendments with effect from the date of signature of this determination.

Clauses 9 and 16 of this determination amend Determination 3725 to increase, with effect from 20 September 1984, Education Assistance Overseas payable to members serving in Indonesia; to decrease with effect from date of signature of this determination, certain rates payable to members serving in the Philippines; and to make minor textual corrections with effect from the date of signature of this determination.

Clauses 11 and 17 of this determination amend Determination 3901:

- a. with effect from 29 March 1985 to increase the rate of
Parking Allowance for members serving in the Philippines;

- b. with effect from 8 April 1985 to increase the excess baggage entitlement for members travelling to or from the Philippines;
- c. with effect from 18 April 1985 to decrease the rate of contribution by some members serving in Indonesia towards the cost of domestic assistance, to introduce a Car Insurance Allowance for members serving in Indonesia, to increase the rate of Driver Allowance for members serving in Jakarta, Indonesia, to increase the rates of Household Assistance Allowance and Watchman Allowance for members serving in Indonesia, to introduce Child Minding Allowance for members serving in the Philippines and to increase the rates of Driver Allowance, Gardening Assistance Allowance and Household Assistance Allowance payable to members serving in the Philippines; and
- d. with effect from the date of signature of this determination to limit the rate of Child Minding Allowance for members serving in Indonesia, to increase the rate of contribution by members serving in Indonesia and the Philippines towards the cost of domestic assistance and to make minor textual amendments.

Determination 3716, Supplementary Living Allowance and Determination 3724, Child Allowance also provide allowances to members who serve on duty overseas to enable them to maintain a standard of living comparable to their standard in Australia by reimbursing the additional costs incurred because of that service overseas.

Clauses 6 and 8 of this determination amend, with effect from date of signature of this determination, Determinations 3716 and 3724 respectively to change the nomenclature of an approving authority to correctly state the title of that authority.

Determination 3737, Medical and Hospital Expenses of a Member's Family Overseas, provides financial assistance to a member who is serving on long term duty overseas and who incurs expenses for the medical treatment of his or her family which exceed those that the member would incur for similar treatment in Australia.

Clause 10 of this determination amends Determination 3737 with effect from the date of signature of this determination to clarify conditions under which a member serving in the Philippines may be reimbursed the cost of nursing care and to permit the senior Service representative to approve payment of certain aspects of the allowance.
