EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DETERMINATION NO. 58 OF 1986

ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE

UNDER SECTION 58B OF THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

Section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 allows the Minister to make determinations on conditions of service for members of the Defence Force.

Determination 0301, District Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members serving in localities classified by the Australian Public Service Board as being isolated districts. The rate of allowance payable depends on the particular grade in which a locality has been classified.

This determination amends Determination 0301 to increase, with effect from 1 May 1986, the rates of District Allowance payable to members serving in isolated districts.
